Generosity as a Weapon: Finding Greed with Openness

This message is about fighting the spirit of more with the power of open. I am just like Creflo Dollar to talk more about mammon and how we need to stop living our lives by mammon and greed. We need to stop being takers and holding onto our wealth. The Devil wants us to live as takers and live our lives being selfish and thinking about ourselves. Do you live in the Old Testament that people were all about themselves? My personal charity status is high every year because I try to avoid greed. When I have the money to give, I like to help the homeless by donating to homeless shelters and churches that house the homeless to keep homeless men and women off the streets. This is why I believe I got my spiritual blueprint and legacy from my biological father's side of the family. My other family members outside of my biological father's side of the family are takers and hold onto their wealth and care more for themselves. We need to help the needy and homeless when they are struggling in bad and tough times. We need to be open to helping other family members that are struggling with bad and tough times. I did not just live in Iowa, Texas, Ohio, Kentucky, Georgia, Alabama, Maryland, New York and Pennsylvania. I live in the cities as a cheerful giver helping the needy and homeless when I had the extra money on me to do so.

I encourage people that receive fixed income to give a portion of the income to help the needy and homeless in 2026. You will realize how good it feels giving and helping someone else, not thinking about yourself all the time while listening to the devil to be a taker. Do not let the devil destroy your spirit for God and let the devil tell you not to care for others. Generosity needs to be part of your spiritual blueprint in 2026 to start strengthening and increase your worship to God and his kingdom. If you have people in your family or friends' inner circle that are selfish, I want you to share what I am sharing with you in this message to your family and friends to eliminate their greed and increase their generosity.

“Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age.”-1 Timothy 6:18-19

Paul warns people that are rich in the present world not to be arrogant or put their hope in wealth. Paul with the attitude and action. Paul says to be rich in good deeds. The scripture talks about beautiful abundance at work in Greek. Our bank account should not be longer than a service account. Paul tells the wealthy that money is a liquid asset that cannot support wealth. Generous people are solidifying their wealth into a foundation that lasts for them in the kingdom. Paul argued that there is a counterfeit life that is built on general revenues with injustice and true life with generosity. Greed offers a life of security through accumulation. The Gospel offers a life of security through distribution. Paul uses the term lay up treasure transferring your assets from the world and injustice to the kingdom. Paul says command them is discipline and generosity of will. We command our resources to move in order to kill the arrogance that wealth creates.

Greed tells you fear will never be enough. You only have to give yourself out of greed is being a Cheerful giver and not being about mammon. We need to start investing in community projects in communities that benefit the homeless and help the needy. We need to help more people in our community because it can help end violence, crime and bullying in our communities. Our children in our communities need a

mentor that they look up to lead them in their life the right way and out of sin. Generosity is the only way to break the power of mammon. We need to stop trusting in government and public assistance with SNAP benefits, SSDI/SSI, Medicaid, Medicare and public assistance. We need to depend on God as our source and breakthrough. The world and possessions in the world is not your source. Greed tells you what you own. A cheerful giver means you do not own anything and have a soul for giving. Giving is part of worship for God. Tell the person next to you and say do not worship the devil. Mishpat is true justice is not afraid of losing their revenues. Greed relies on the lie that the barn is empty. Generosity operates on the barn principle. Greed is a surplus that God has as the source. Giving is a declaration of war against the Spirit of lack. Greed wants us to build a monument of ourselves. Generosity builds bridges to others.

1. When you feel like you are living in greed, you need to give something away immediately. I have done this since 2011 after I was born again on September 4, 2011.
2. You need to start training your spirit to respond to greed with openness.
3. Give 10% of your wealth in tithing to avoid greed.
4. Give out of your vision.

I encourage you to use your generosity as a weapon in 2026 to clear the path to God's kingdom. A person that lives life with generosity and giving will receive more blessings from God. When you go home after this service, I want you to write down things that you are holding on too tightly. Are you holding onto a dream, specific dollar amount, goal, particular career or piece of property.

What is the open hand move you can make to prove that greed is not your master?

I am asking you to do a Generosity Impact and Peace Tracker in 2026 to control your greed. This will reduce your stress and increase your spiritually. Why do I want to hoard? How much did I give? Who was helped?

- Generosity breaks the power of possession.
- Generosity destroys the illusion of scarcity.
- Generosity targets the roots of legacy.

I want to add a true story about myself and my generosity in communities. I believe I got my generosity attitude from my biological father's side of the family because my grandmother gave me money while I was in high school 2-3 times a week when she volunteered and gave me money. It is like my grandma helped me and volunteered to help me out financially and economically in bad and tough times. I believed my mother had a cheerful giver attitude that was deeply involved in the church and served as a Sunday school teacher at her church. I had aunt and uncles that were able to help me when I was a child and when I was in my 20s and low 30s while I was either in poverty and needed financial help. My biological father is able to help me in bad and tough times from back then to the present. I want to say in my heart that I thank the generosity that I received from my biological father's side of the family because I couldn't get the generosity from other family members outside of my biological father's side of the family. My aunt's name Joyce really opened my eyes years ago because my mother side of the family and stepfather always negatively attacked them saying my biological father side of the family have never done anything for me. My eyes today are still wide open about that because I remember in bad and tough times that I was able to go to my biological father's side of the family for emergency financial help.

I actually have heard homeless men and women go through this with their families. I heard homeless men and women complain that their families will not help them get back on their feet and let them sit and sleep at a homeless shelter. That is why we need to have more family reunions with our entire families like what happened in the movie "Madea Family Reunion" to reunite families and bring families together. My advice to you and those people out there that no family should go for help. When your biological barn is empty or built on a foundation of mammon, it feels like you are standing on a spiritual island. I mean you have a family that relies on living their life on their greed and worldliness. The Legacy Blueprint seminars teach members and the wider community to increase their generosity and decrease their greed and worldly desires. I think landlords for apartments and shared room housing need to decrease their greed and make housing more affordable by ending price gauging to increase rent on tenants and looking for permanent housing. You have families in the world that operate on the rules of mammon. If you are dealing with biological families that rather live their life by rules of mammon, I encourage people to step and start a covenant family because they can share their spiritual values. Families that live by mammon get help from control and manipulation. Families still operate on the rules of mammon, are still lost spiritually and need to save souls to bring more people to Christ. Joseph was sold by his family out of greed. God provided a new house for him in Egypt. If you are surrounded by family members who still live their life by the rules of mammon, I encourage you to go to a church and find a church home to build a safety net and support system for yourself. This can reduce stress, stealing and beating false witnesses against others, and hate. A covenant family will teach us to love our neighbors and live our life with the fruit of the spirit. I continue to encourage you to connect to a mentor that is like Paul and an encourager in the church to start your legacy blueprint from scratch and have a spiritual family. A covenant family in a church will not neglect you and you will be building a legacy blueprint that will stand with you. An encourager is called Barnabas in the Bible. We need to follow the widow of Zarephath that had no family to depend on for help and Zarephath ended putting God first. If we have families that cannot come through for us to help us, we need to put God first at the center of our life. We do not need to put the world and government first. God is our heavenly Father and we need to honor God as our personal Savior and heavenly Father. I encourage you to use the altar as your safety net if you have no one else to go to and honor God as your provider. You must set boundaries to protect your mishpat. Abraham, Gideon and Ruth had to walk away from their father's house for rules of mammon and lack of generosity. I encourage you to love your family and friends without letting greed infect your barn. That is what I did is continue to use my legacy blueprint from my biological father side of the family with my spiritual foundation and generosity. I have to continue to walk away from my other family members because of the lack, of generosity and rules of mammon to depend on my legacy blueprint and the altar as my safety net. Things I encourage you not to do or to do:

- Do not go to family for financial advice
- Do not let family guilt trip you into Mammon based decisions
- Keep your legacy blueprint private until it is strong enough to withstand their criticism

I encourage you and people in your family that do live their life to their legacy blueprint with generosity to say this prayer to yourself to yourself on your knees to meditate daily. The church will start a covenant kin program for people that need support and safety net in their life for people that do not have no one. The small group will have covenant mentors and will be managed by the Family and Discipleship Ministry. The small group of covenant members will help people that do not have family that support them and guide them to make life decisions. The covenant mentor will meet once a month with you or

individuals to discuss your spiritual growth, budget, and savings goals. It will be Oakland County with church operations. The covenant mentor will serve as the first call when a person is going through a crisis and will help you or an individual through the situation even if it is related to family and friends problems. The covenant mentor is perfect for people that loved ones recently and in the past that are still dealing hurt from their passing. The covenant mentor will guide you to practice Avodah in the Workplace or on your job. The covenant mentor will help you or an individual with setting boundaries with family members.
