Jeremiah 29:8-14 John 6:45-71

I am just going to Chicago for a while because I need to do pastoral duties and take care of church operations out there. I am the type of person that I do not no longer let people hold me back for anything and goals. I am mostly friends with pastors and religious leaders. I am still friends with people I went to high school and elementary school with, but they are all successful like me with good careers and jobs with college degrees.

I moved to Detroit in February 2022 to April 2023. I moved and lived in Houston in April 2023 to January 2024. I moved and lived in Philadelphia in February 2024 to May 2024. Now, I have lived in Brooklyn since June 2024. When I think about the phrase false prophets, I think about running away from haters, conflicts and envious people by moving from city-to-city since 2015. I feel like running right now but I don't. I just have to go to Chicago and handle some church operations as senior pastor on July 31, 2024. The plan to be headquartered in Brooklyn from Southeast Michigan. I need to settle and let God plan my life and guide me like what staff at Star of Hope Mission in Houston told me to do and stop thinking too fast. I am a follower of Jesus that will continue to share my message. When we read Jeremiah 29:11, I think about the homeless at homeless shelters not letting God plan their life. Homeless men and women are anxious to get out of homeless shelters to go back to being conformed to the world and sin. What are they thinking? I am thankful for the good advice and mentoring I got from staff at Star of Hope Mission in Houston for letting God guide me to friendships and relationships to guide to righteous and good dialogue. I want to be honest that I am not able to do that in any other part of NYC. I am able to do that and build friendships in Brooklyn. That's a 100% fact. Some people hate on me because I am a pastor and religious leader, but I do not care because I let God guide me and continue to be a breakthrough for me in my life. I am not friends and do not like to meet new people that are people pleasers because I live my life by Galatians 1:10 and Colossians 3:23. Christ Jesus was not a people pleaser and I won't either on earth. One thing I say about people pleasers that people make friends with other people that way in this economy. My teachers said while I was young that it is called buying friendship. I still keep my autographed bible that was given to me on commencement at Star of Hope Mission in Houston in October 2023.
