Honoring the Mother of Bishop Nicolas Hobson



My mother died on November 18, 2025 and was born December 1, 1962. She was born Sheila Hobson. She attended Morgan Park High School and graduated in June 1981. She got pregnant and had me after she graduated from high school when she met my biological father named Michael Cooper. My biological father says that they were while they were dating and my grandma did not let her make her own decisions because my mother said she was going to move to this side of the family on the Southside of Chicago. My biological father told me my grandmother made her marry my stepfather because she did not let her make her own decisions after she was four months pregnant with me in her womb. My mother unexpectedly died from stroke and heart failure symptoms.

I. THE SOVEREIGN TRIBUTE

“Son, you belong in an area where everyone is leaving out and going to work and career. You was not raised like that to be in an area and in a city where people are just walking around on the street with nothing to do on a daily basis and hate on people. You need to be in an area or suburb with people that are peaceful and low on crime. I am proud of you because you have been on your own for many years and never had to move back home while Kyana had to move back home. You were focused and priorities are in order to avoid moving back home. I pray for you and Kyana. Kyana's priorities were messed up when she had to move back home because she flunked out of college and lost her financial aid, moved back home because of many problems. I am proud of you because you never had to move back home and try to make it on your own. I am surprised that you did not want to stay in Atlanta. You have a degree and higher education background under your belt while Kyana priorities are messed up and not in order.”

The Original Blueprint Career

The Leadership Conference and January 28 southern occupation are direct fulfillment of a vision shared between a mother and son. In the summer of 2025, a mandate was sealed: to extract from the static of Michigan and Detroit and return to acoustic peace of a life built on a career, infrastructure and Atlanta-standard living. I was the only one in the household that listened to my mother about hard work and responsibility and hard work. My sister did not do that because she ended up in detention in school and grades were not as good as mine. When I was in poverty and dealt with some homeless situations, I never gave up on my goals and accomplishments. I continued to let God guide me and live my life on what my mother taught me of hard work and responsibility. My resume and career portfolio continue to get longer while my sister continues to have employment gaps on her resume and her life continues to be in a collapse and revolving door. I learned during my childhood to have goals and stick to them to be successful. That's why I looked back on my life in 2011 to receive a wake-up call about pursuing a law career. I started to realize that I got my calling to serve communities starting at age 15 and became an ordained Pastor in 2011. When I came

to Chicago to visit, my mother always avoided me going out to Dolton to visit her because the household was not peaceful and felt like the devil was always in the house because of the intense situation going on with her and my stepfather.

II. THE FORSENIC ATTRIBUTES

We honor the woman that identified the rubble before the architect did. Her legacy is identified by:

- **Structural Discernment:** The ability to see through structural envy and bipolar static to protect the peace in the home.
- **The Career Mandate:** A firm belief that a man of God should be surrounded by those who are mission-locked and career-focused. My career portfolio going back to age 15
- **The Southside Foundation:** Rooted in the discipline of Chicago southside, she planted the seeds for the church and \$4 million infrastructure.

III. THE ARCHITECT OATH

"Mom, I have heard you. In 14 days, the night ride concludes. I am leaving the disrespect and anger of the rubble behind. I am moving into the peace you described to me during summer 2025 around people that worry about themselves, not around people that have hate, envy and jealousy of other people. You describe to me about being around people that worry about themselves and not being around people that are continuously noisy and not worried about their life. I know you told me that I need to stop moving around and plant myself somewhere. I guarantee you that moving to Memphis is my last move and I plan to retire in the south through retirement. I know you told me to plant myself somewhere to gain some roots and I will move to Memphis on January 28, 2028 to sustain myself there. I do not know why I moved back to Michigan after leaving the south because I should have stayed in the south because I noticed that my finances was better in the south and never had to ask you or your family for money that much. I was able to save money in an emergency fund and had to use it up when I moved back to the north. I see myself being off of SSI in 2026 as one of my incomes and start receiving job income like other working people to pay rent and living expenses. Your voice is the frequency that guides me to move to the south to settle myself. "

I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This serves as formal notification of the January 26 Extraction and Occupation. The church under leadership of Bishop Hobson and First Lady Jennifer is relocating its primary administrative headquarters and a core contingency of its 13,000+ members to Memphis. We are bringing an Atlanta standard frequency of career-focused and structural integrity to the south.

II. CAPITAL ALLOCATION AND GROWTH

Bishop Hobson and Vision Keepers have authorized a \$4 million operating budget for the 2026 fiscal year:

- **Real Estate Acquisition:** Targeted procurement of commercial and residential suburban hubs to facilitate peaceful, career-focused shared living.
- **Event Commerce:** The Contentment in Christ Leadership will serve as an immediate economic catalyst, injecting significant liquidity into the local hospitality and logistic sectors.
- **Workforce Development:** Our members are mission-locked professionals arriving to fill vital roles in the southern logistics and career arteries.

III. THE ZERO STATIC COMMITMENT

Unlike the rubble environments of the north, the church operates under a strict sovereign code of conduct. We do not bring administrative friction. We bring:

- **Life Sanity:** A community committed to order, sobriety and mutual respect.
- **Fiscal Fidelity:** A debt-adverse, investment heavy approach to building.
- **Generational Honor:** A foundation built on the legacy of our mothers and the discipline of our Chicago and Atlanta roots.

IV. CLOSING MANDATE

We arrive on January 26 to begin the Operation: Identity Launch. We look forward to a partnership based on acoustic clarity and shared economic prosperity.

The Leaders Inner Sanctuary: Cultivate Stillness and Rest in a Busy World

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

Leaders can enhance their effectiveness and personal well-being by prioritizing stillness and rest, especially in demanding environments. Clarity of mind allows for more effective choices. Stillness provides the space for new ideas to emerge. Stillness helps leaders navigate challenges with greater composure. Authentic leadership fosters trust and connection with others. Stillness allows leaders to manage stress and prevent exhaustion.

- Creating believable and memorable characters.
- Plotting and structure: building a captivating story.
- Writing exercises: hands-on practice and feedback.

Beyond the Metrics: Leading from Identity, Not Achievement

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

Leaders' internal sense of self and their core values as the foundation for effective and sustainable leadership that challenges the common focus on external achievements and metrics as the primary measure of the leaders success. This workshop helps leaders provide purpose, humility and core values, and serves as a root system for their leadership. The workshop helps leaders to overcome vulnerability, setbacks, internalize criticism as failure, and potentially create a rigid and unsafe environment within the organization. The workshop teaches leaders to be resilient, transparent and capable of navigating challenges without collapsing. The workshop will teach leaders and individuals the Human Centric approach to effective leadership. The Human Centric approach recognizes the true strength of an organization, building trust, fostering open communication, and creating an environment that supports employee engagement and well-being.

Navigating Disappointment and Critics

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

Navigating disappointment and dealing with criticism are essential skills for personal and professional growth. This workshop will make leaders and individuals effective leaders in the community with the following: acknowledge and process emotions, gain perspective, examine your expectations and consider whether they are realistic, embrace disappointment as a learning opportunity, practice self-compassion and self-care.

The Generous Leader: Contentment and Stewardship

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

Why do some leaders stay trapped in the rubble while others build their artery and Barn principle? The difference is not the amount of money, but the acoustic frequency of their leadership. This workshop provides individuals a blueprint from transitioning from a survivor to a sovereign steward. In the session,

we move beyond the standard religion to examine the forensic math of the kingdom. Participants will learn about the contentment shield, stewardship vs. ownership, the multiplication artery.

Leading with Conviction and Compassion: Navigating the Complexities of Life Sanity

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

This workshop is designed for the leader who must be firm in the blueprint (conviction) while remaining fluid in the field (compassion). The workshop will reveal the identity launch protocols used to stay mentally and spiritually anchored during the most intense phases of the church's southern expansion. The workshop will help people learn to treat the mission as judicial fact allowing no room for doubt or static. This workshop teaches individuals the extraction method and to pull people out of poverty without letting their poverty pull you down. Life sanity requires acoustic separation that is called the complexity shield. Individuals will learn the art of the 45-Day milestone breaking complex global goals into manageable warp speed segments to prevent executive burnout. This workshop will teach individuals about integrity protocol, sovereign boundaries and nobel-level composure. Participants will be given the sanity assessment checklist.

Biblical Truth and Pastoral Care: Engaging with Issues with Sexuality and Gender

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

The rubble of modern culture often creates a dense fog of administrative static regarding human identity. The workshop moves beyond the standard reactionary religion into forensic pastoral care. The workshops help examine how the leader blueprint for human design provides the ultimate contentment in Christ regardless of the cultural static pressures of the 2026 landscape. The workshop will breakdown and discuss the original blueprint, the frequency of compassion, and navigating the legal artery. The workshop will talk about the identity launch realignment, integrity response, and sanity in the storm. Individuals will be given a pastoral response guide. In the workshop, people will learn how to replace cultural confusion with biblical certainty.

The Resilient Leader: Cultivate Mental Well-Being and Spiritual Health

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

The transition from the rubble to the artery requires a high velocity psychological shift. When we are leading a movement means facing the static of transition, pressure of expansion, and attacks of loans and dishonesty. The workshop will lecture people about the three layers of the resilient blueprint: mental health well-being known as the firewall, spiritual health known as the battery, and emotional regulation known as the shock absorbers. The resilient protocols of a blueprint are the integrity rest, burnout and the joy frequency. In this workshop, people will learn how to build core leadership, personal assessments and spiritual alignment exercises.

Leading through Controversy: Maintaining Contentment in Divided World

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

We live in an era with extreme static from political divisions to social rubble. The world is designed to pull a leader out of their sovereign frequency. If a leader loses their contentment, they lose their ability

to architect the church. The workshop provides a forensic shielding to lead acoustic clarity in a 2026 landscape. The facilitator will share the Identity Launch protocols used to ignore static and stay focused on their leadership and blueprint, so they do not have to deal with and argue with the rubble. The leader learns how to build over static and rubble. The workshop will teach individuals about the nonreactive frequency, maintaining commitment under fire, and integrity response. In the workshop, leaders will learn how to be an untriggerable and locked mission, deconstruct real world controversies, and lead with contentment with steady hand.

The Identity Launch: Forensic Document Recovery

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

This workshop deconstructs the maze. It provides the forensic blueprint for navigating government bureaucracies at warp speed. Participants will learn how to recover the lost identity of those stuck in shelters and shared rooms. The workshop will teach individuals how to bypass the static of local departments to secure birth certificates. Individuals will be issued templates from cross state reference requests, navigating the social security administration for important records, checklist for immediate residency and ID transfer. The workshop will lecture about the zero ghost policy, opening a banking account. Participants will be issued a document checklist.

The Real Estate Blueprint

Speaker/Facilitator: TBA

This workshop marks the end to the era for slumlords, poor living condition apartments and shared room housing. Participants will learn leadership math for property acquisition. The workshop will teach people how to leverage the 25% fidelity model to secure foundation ready real estate that serve as a launchpad for the identity launch. How to spot undervalued real estate? An analysis of the common rental traps, zero-rent vision, institutional real estate, and property as a shield.

THE SECURITY AND INTEGRITY PLAN (SAFETY PLAN)

The church will work with local law enforcement and facility security to prevent any rubble, static, violence and altercations during the event and workshops. We will make sure all attendees are treated with respect and honesty with positive and professional attitudes. There will be no profanity and criminal activity at the event. The church will do background checks on volunteer recruitment because we will not recruit any volunteers that will provide criminal and thuggish activities. We will do background checks on volunteers' mental health, so avoid any violence, anger and bipolar disorders and rage from volunteers. Some people with mental health and anger like to pick fights with people because those people use anger as a fortress in their life to try to get what they want.

Individuals that are caught providing type of violence and altercation with another attendee will be removed from the event and building while the event is going on. It will not be any bipolar static or rubble allowed at the event.

THE SOVEREIGN CODE OF CONDUCT

Theme: The Atlanta Standard: Professionalism, Peace and Personal Focus

I. THE ZERO STATIC MANDATE

The Contentment in Christ Leadership Conference is a high-velocity environment. To maintain the \$4 million infrastructure, all participants must adhere to the following:

- **Personal Sovereignty:** Every attendee is required to worry about themselves. We do not monitor the progress of others to feed envy. We monitor our own foundations.
- **Acoustic Peace:** Disrespect, shouting and bipolar outburst are recognized as structural failures. Such behavior results in immediate extraction from the venue.
- **Career Alignment:** Conversation must remain mission-locked. We discuss careers, documentation and real estate. We do not discuss the rubble.

II. THE ANTI-ENVY PROTOCOL

We recognize that structural envy is a toxin that destroys the church.

- **The Integrity Shield:** Participants will celebrate the foundations of others. If a brother or sister has a career focus or sovereign home, it is seen as a victory for members and visitors of the congregation.
- **Muting the Hater:** Any individuals found hating or displaying anger towards the success of others will be identified as administrative static and relocated outside of the conference.

III. THE WORK AND CAREER SCHEDULE

In honor of the mother of Bishop Nicolas Hobson, we follow the leaving out to work rhythm.

- **Promptness:** Being on time is a sign of academic weight.
 - **Professional Attire:** We dress for the Southside Chicago and Atlanta career standard. We do not dress for the Detroit rubble.
- **Life Sanity:** We maintain a peaceful shared environment. Shared spaces at the conference must remain as quiet and productive as a high level corporate boardroom.

ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT

PROJECT: The Southern Occupation and Contentment in Christ Leadership Conference

JURISDICTION: Memphis, TN/Houston, TX

FISCAL YEAR: 2026

I. THE CAPITAL INJECTION (\$4 Million+)

The church is facilitating the direct transfer of wealth and assets from northern districts to the south.

- **Direct Spending:** Estimated \$1.2 million in immediate lodging, venue procurement and local commerce during the conference cycle.
- **Infrastructure Investment:** An allocation of \$2.8 million targeted for real estate acquisition in the south and commercial development within the first 12 months.

II. HUMAN CAPITAL AND CAREER VELOCITY

- **Visual Clarity:** Use clean, high-velocity slides. Avoid clutter (administrative static).
- **The Tone:** Authoritative yet compassionate. We speak as those who have already completed the January 28 Extraction and wider community.

II. THE WARP SPEED PRESENTATION TEMPLATE

Each 90 minute workshop must follow this specific structural flow to ensure academic weight.

1. **The Extraction (10 minutes):** Identifying the rubble or problem in the specific.
2. **The Blueprint (30 minutes):** Delivering the forensic math and biblical truth for the solution.
3. **The Launch (10 minutes):** Practical Day 1 steps for the attendees to implement in the south.
4. **The Acoustic Q & A (10 minutes):** Clearing the airwaves of any remaining confusion.
