

Do not be a Fan of Satan Kingdom

Bishop Hobson is not mad at his family members, but he just stops communicating with them because they are takers and do not give to God in order to receive blessings from God. Bishop Hobson is not mad at his family members and stops communicating with them because they spend 99% of the time talking and gossiping about people in their conversations with other people. When a person goes to church as an active churchgoer, they are supposed to live as disciples and Christians not to bear false witness against others. After his family members gossip and talk about others trying to be judgmental, I realize that I cannot talk and be around people like that until they get their act together to be Christians and disciples. His family members do not support him financially and economically by giving any tithe or offering to the congregation he founded in 2014. Bishop Hobson's mother and stepfather's marriage has been feeling like it is falling apart weekly because they do not go to church or give any tithe or offering to God. His grandmother is an active churchgoer living in Chicago and she bears false witness against others, gossiping and talking about people negatively outside of church. In his previous sermons, he spoke about that and called those types of people lopsided Christians. We must be whole Christians and disciples to serve and honor God as the rock of your salvation. As First Lady, my family members are cheerful givers that help the poor and homelessness, give to God with tithes and offerings in church, read the Bible and speak to God to help us in our lives, volunteer at homeless shelters to feed and help the homelessness. My side of the family supported his personal grassroots project called Pastor Hobson Homelessness Initiative in 2010-2014. Bishop Hobson family members will not help him out financially and economically for many years, so he did what he had to do to survive on his own without family and asked others like friends to help him out financially and

economically. It means when he lived in the struggle while living in Chicago without help from family. When he was living in Chicago at the time, his mother was my representative payee for my SSI income using my benefits as an income stream for her because she did have income for herself. She used to steal money out of my SSI income every month for himself, so God was guiding him at the time that he told me to move out of Chicago to get out of poverty. His well-being has somewhat improved after he moved out of Chicago and his mother was not his representative payee for his SSI income any more. Bishop Hobson gained 33% personal public charity status helping the homeless since 2011 based on receipts, personal finances and tax returns. Bishop Hobson does not live fancy and rich lifestyles because he says you can ask anybody that knows him in Michigan, Iowa, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Kentucky, Georgia, Alabama and Ohio. His monthly and weekly income was never a lot of money, but he is still able to give and be a cheerful giver since 2013. Bishop Hobson got his calling to preach later in 2011, so he started the Pastor Hobson Homelessness Initiative in 2014 and founded his own congregation in 2014 after the Pastor Hobson Homelessness Initiative. Everything he does on earth today going back to 2011 is serving God 99.9% of the time. He does not get things and possessions in life no more by the flesh, devil, trials, tribulations, temptation and darkness. His receiving help from others and giving to God has motivated him to help others and the poor that are hurting in their life. God has chosen and used him to preach the gospel and help the poor.

As Christians and disciples, we must not neglect the poor and homelessness because we must help them to seek God as a person that has a lost soul and lives for Satan. We must pull them away from Satan and his kingdom. Some homeless men and women do not like to stay at homeless shelters because they always talk about living with their spiritual self at homeless shelters. Serving and living for God is not a bad thing to do in your life. Serving and living for God is a good thing to do in your life because you want to be in the Holy of Holies in the Tabernacle, receive reward from God with your prayers daily, protect your soul and give eternal life to get to heaven. If you think it is good to live your life based on pride, it is not because you are listening to the devil and his kingdom. Bishop Hobson felt neglect from my family members during childhood, but he never went out and started listening to ideology that led me down the path of unrighteousness, joining gangs, and providing violence in communities. He just held his head up to God to let God guide him in his life while living in Iowa, Michigan, Ohio, Kentucky, Alabama, Georgia and Pennsylvania. He thanked God for his well-being, giving him food to eat and roof over his head, job income and being able to let God use him in his life. When Bishop Hobson was not working at the time when he was an undergraduate student or done with college, he did not fall into depression and oppression when he did not have a job. He knows God always has his back in his life. He did not go out and provide violence in communities from not having a job. All he has done is keep himself active in the workforce and provide sector by doing volunteer work as organizations. That's why he does not have gaps on his resume and he has a long resume with strong college background, professional experience, volunteer work,

involvement in student activities as an undergraduate, involvement in membership associations in Chicago.

If you are dealing with neglect from friends and family in your life, do you need to follow the path of Bishop Hobson on what he did in his life to see the person you see today as the Bishop and senior pastor of the congregation.

- If you are homeless or afraid to live in a homeless shelter, you do not need to be afraid to live in a homeless shelter and live by your spiritual self at homeless shelters. You deserve to be happy to serve under God's covenant and let God guide you in your life. It is good to serve God and live for God while you are homeless because you can learn from other homeless people around you with their true story about how God saved them and helped them in their life.
- If you are stuck living in a homeless shelters after dealing with family neglecting you, you want to let God guide you in the Holy Spirit and surprise your family members when they see you again in the near future or later in your life on how you transformed your life over to Christ and living obedient to God.
- If you are stuck being homeless and living in a homeless shelter, you can let God guide you to obtain permanent housing, finding employment, and buying food.
- If you need food to eat daily and cannot rely on family to help you financially and economically, it is good to let God guide you to put food on your table and give you food to eat daily. Bishop Hobson has a track record helping homeless people and low-income people to get to nonprofit organizations to get them a hot meal out of his own personal money. He says there is no reason for people to starve and deal with food hunger daily living on the streets with no money for food.
- Try to keep haters and people that continue to bear false witness against others on other people. We need to stop being judgemental and gossiping about other people around us because we do not know people in public and around us to judge and gossip about them. We need to be around more christians and disciples around us to continue to motivate us to keep God and the Holy Spirit in our life.
 - Pray for enemies and wickedness
 - Increase discipleship and stewardship to God and the Holy Spirit
 - Believe the devil is a lie and a liar.
