"What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but does not have work? Can such faith save him? If a brother or sister is without clothes and lacks daily food and one you say to them, Go in peace, stay warm and be well fed, but you don't give them what the body needs, what good is it? In the same way faith, if it does not have works, is dead by itself. But someone will say you have faith without works, and I will show you faith by my works. You believe that God is one. Good! Even the demons believe and they shudder."-James 2:14-19

Say to the person next to you and say continue to build your faith in God to distance ourselves from the sinful world. It is too much sin and temptation in the world that causes us to use our freewill the wrong way and leads us to unrighteousness. You have people in the world that cause us to use sin to the world to get what they want in the world. Homeless Men and women need to understand that faith in God will save you from sin and temptation in the sinful world. When you have direction in your life with faith in God, you are letting God give you a vision for your life with the Spiritual Recovery Program. When I was in the RLC program after commencement in October 2024, I learned to have a vision and avoid pain in your life. I was taught and encouraged to do a vision log while I was at the TLC program. There were times when I was homelessness and not homelessness, I was always blessed with food daily. Some days in the past I just decided to fast because I did not have food to eat that particular day. When I was in Chicago, there were days that did not have anything to eat and no soup kitchens were open for community meals. It was days that I did not have money to buy food to eat.

What do we need to do to have faith in God and the Holy Spirit in our life going forward?

- 1. Read the bible daily
- 2. Understand and study the bible daily
- 3. Trust God as your healer, provider, protector, provider and trust God as our source
- 4. Do not trust the world as your source.
- 5. Do good by others and be willing to help others.
- 6. Honor and live obedient to God as rock of your salvation

We must understand that food and clothes are blessings for all of us. Homeless men and women on the streets must understand that having a roof over your head, food and clothes that organizations and homeless shelters provide to the blessings are a blessing to people. It is even a blessing to homeless people that do not have nothing when they come to homeless shelters and they need a blessing from God.

When homeless people at homeless shelters are there or in a place for a reason because homeless people that are at homeless shelters with no place to go is a blessing to them. Homeless people that live on the streets and sleep on the streets need to understand homeless shelters are blessings to people because they are well fed, clothes and roof over your head. Homeless men and women with no place to call home need to understand homeless shelters are good that offer blessings to people that need to be fed, clothes and roof over their head. Faith in God works when you have strong faith in God and the Holy Spirit. In Baltimore, I like to start providing bible study groups with people in the community and devotion meetings like I always do in the past.

Scriptures to memorize to strengthen our faith in God and Holy Spirit:

1. "Trust in the Lord will all your heart, and not rely on your own understanding."-Proverbs 3:5-6

I live and honor the scripture in my life daily. After I completed the Spiritual Recovery Program at Star of Hope Mission in Houston, I learned how to let God guide me in my life to avoid me making decisions too fast and quickly. When I make decisions too fast and quickly, it causes final consequences economically and financially that always cause me to I end up in situations where I am struggling financially. We need to stop ourselves living in bondage and temptation to the world.

2. "And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him."-Hebrews 11:6

If you do not have faith in God, it is impossible to please God without faith in God. When you continue to do sin and live in bondage, people are not pleasing to God and the Holy Spirit. When you continue to sin and live in idolatry in the world, it is impossible to please God. Only way you can 100% please God in your life is to confess and repent your sins. God will forgive you for your sins.

3. "For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life."-John 3:16

You must believe in God as the rock of your salvation and personal savior. You must trust God as the rock of your salvation and personal savior. You must understand heaven is the key to living under God's grace and eternal and everlasting life. You must understand God's gift to eternal life in heaven after you die on earth.
