I am happy that I do not live my life by mammon because I have been a cheerful giver to Christ Jesus, changed my venue to heaven from earth, and have compassion to give back to communities. I do not serve as Bishop of Lord Jesus Christ Community Baptist Church for the money. I served as Bishop of the congregation for my compassion and willingness to serve Christ Jesus to remain distant from the sinful world. I gave over \$3,000 of my own personal money to help the homeless and individuals in poverty in Chicago, Detroit, Cleveland and Louisville based on my personal tax returns in past tax filings in 2014-2019. I have to work on balancing my cheerful giving and care about myself like my case manager Mr. Gray told me during our meetings in Level 5 in the Spiritual Recovery Program at Star of Hope Mission in Houston. I like Star of Hope Mission better in Houston because they help me and other clients with their spiritual and economic issues. I do not believe no homeless shelter is forcing people to worship God because people have the freewill to do what they want to do. I like spiritual homeless shelters better because I like homeless shelters that have chapel services and a spiritual environment. I disagree with homeless shelters in this nation that say they do not believe in forcing religion and making people worship God as their source and personal savior. It is good for homeless men and women to see God in their life and some homeless shelters that do not offer religion as a part of their operation say they do not believe in forcing religion on homeless men and women to help individuals seek God in their life. I agree with that 100%. I like Star of Hope Mission in Houston because they have religious leaders and spiritual people on staff to help clients keep their spiritual edge. I want to thank Star of Hope Mission in Houston staff for their help in maintaining and improving my spiritual edge to God and Holy Spirit with very high praise. When I worship and honor Luke 16:9-13 and Matthew 6:24 daily, I let God guide me more and not people in the world. I let any professional help me economically only one percent of the time and let God guide me 99% of the time. That is 100% fact. Since 2011, I have tried to keep the world, mammon and devil out of the way in my life. I will continue to oppose the LGBT community and stand my ground to support all couples as men and women with children. I get mammon out of the way and do not let people encourage

me to make decisions based on mammon. I do not listen to the sinful world today that wants people to make life decisions based on mammon and unrighteousness even during hard economic times. I want to thank the staff at Star of Hope Mission in Houston for helping me with my tribulations and planning my life with God guidance. I serve and only listen to one God known as Christ Jesus and heavenly father at the throne in heaven. I only listen to what Jesus tells me to do at the throne in heaven to accomplish my goals here on earth in this present time going into the future. Christ Jesus is in my heart daily that plans my life and plans my life after the five month Spiritual Recovery Program at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston. Since 2011, I have been keeping fools, idolatry and mammon out of my inner circle. My contentment to God is to continue my goals. He helps me from the throne set for me, not to anyone in the world in my life along with my present life on earth. I do not listen to the sinful world because I understand the sinful world is trying to cause people to be unsure of themselves and put the devil in more control of their life. That is 100% fact. Weak contentment to God means being unsure of yourself on earth. I learned all of this at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston in Sanctification and learned how to read the bible in context in classes in level 1-5 in Spiritual Recovery Program. I volunteered for my first day at Bowery Mission in the New York City area during lunch shift yesterday. I am scheduled to volunteer at the Bowery Mission on Monday during lunch shift at 12:00-2:00 PM. I do volunteering at homeless shelters for spiritual purposes because shepherding is one of my spiritual gifts. When I read the bible and scriptures, the scripture of Luke 16:9-13 and Matthew 6:24 are speaking to me because Christ Jesus is speaking to me. Clients and staff at Star of Hope Mission in Houston say that God and the spirit is speaking to me with a wall of angels around me daily to protect me from this sinful world, idolatry and mammon. People like myself still will have tribulations we need to work on daily. As a shepherd and spiritual, I let God work out my problems and not mammon and the world. People that do not believe in God working out people's problems are sinful and still conformed to the sinful world full of idolatry and unrighteousness.

I will take my case manager Mr. Gray advice from Star of Hope Mission in Houston to maintain myself in place and not move around no more. As an independent since 2010, my top issues in elections are the economy, lowering government spending and shrinking the size of government and federal government, only support limited government with balanced budget amendment, more affordable housing, ending homelessness, lower and less taxes in economy, no economic regulations and raising the debt ceiling, small business and immigration.

When I read 2 Chronicles 16:1-9, I strongly believed all along that God looked out for me and chose me out of all my family members. God encourages me not to listen and be obedient to mammon and sinful world. That's why Christ Jesus feels like he keeps a wall of angels around me daily. A spiritual woman in church in Cleveland in 2017 told me I am at the front of the line through the gates of heaven if I die today on earth today. Christ Jesus recognizes my good heart for the kingdom and helping the poor out of my

own personal money in Atlanta, Chicago, Cleveland, New York, Philadelphia, Houston and Birmingham. When I read and take in 2 Chronicles 16:1-9, I strongly believe God is a lot stronger than people on earth. All people do on earth is encourage others to live in idolatry, sin and mammon. It seems like there are less people on earth that are like myself that want to 100% live for God and turn away from sin and mammon in the world. My past sermons on improving our inner circle and increasing our 12 disciples like Jesus did is important to us to keep spirituality in our life including keeping life decision making from mammon and idolatry.
