Tell Them What God Did

Heavenly Father,

Thank you for the food we were able to eat this morning in our households and homeless shelters because homeless people living on the streets do not have food to eat and have to think where their next meal will come from.

I ask you to bless homeless men and women on the streets by giving them the wisdom and knowledge to get out the streets, so they can have a warm place to sleep, meals and food to eat daily and access to the bathroom with a shower.

Strengthen more people christian and faithful, walk to God to follow in my footsteps to share their testimonies and personal stories to others.

Guide and help more people seek God in their life and hearts, so their life can grow as a mustard seed to heaven.

I want to start off telling you a true story and me on what God did for me while I was living my Christian and faithful walk to God and his kingdom through the gates of heaven. I have been an ambassador to Christ since 2014, but I used to keep what God did for me to myself. I am happy to share a new testimony with you that I know as a christian and disciple that God is blessing me now and in the next few weeks. It means making it more established in Brooklyn economically, financially and spiritually. Soon, I will only worry about my well-being in Brooklyn and living in Brooklyn. I never shared the goodness of God for what Christ Jesus has done for me in my life before my time at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston last year. Now, I am proud to share my story about the goodness of God in my life through testimonies and what God has done for me in my life. I have been speaking very highly of the Spiritual Recovery Program at Star of Hope Mission in Houston and no place else because the program has improve myself and spirituality with staff and case manager named Mr. Gray. I liked the prayer listening logs, virtue logs, log on brotherly love and fasting for two days. After the Star of Hope Mission in Houston, the program taught me how to improve myself to become more open and honest about myself to avoid keeping goodness of God and other stuff to myself. I only let God guide me through my life decisions more after the guidance from spiritual staff from Star of Hope Mission in Houston. I do not listen to the sinful world for answers. I want to stay away from making decisions being conformed to the world and mammon.

Questions to ask ourselves while living our christian and faithful walk to God.

1. What does salvation in Jesus mean to you?
2. How can you be better prepared to share your story with others?
3. When you behold the heavens, what do you discover from God?

I use my spiritual gifts in shepherding, prophecy, knowledge, teaching wisdom and exhortation to share my personal stories and testimonies to others to strengthen my christian and faithful walk to God daily. I use my spiritual gifts to continue to get the devil out of the way in my life forever. Say God is the answer. Turn to the person next to you and say God is the answer in your life to help with problems and tribulations. That's why I encourage you and others you know at the workplace and personally to turn from the mammon and sinful world. People in this world want us to use our freewill to live in bondage and mammon, so it can open the door for the devil to control our minds and life to live in the sinful world. Turn to the person next to you and say the devil is wrong and a liar. LGBT community is nothing but the devil and his sinful action encourages people to live in the sinful world to prevent us from being righteous to get to heaven after people die on earth. I do not believe in homosexuality and LGBT community. I strongly believe LGBT community is 100% sinful and needs immediate transformation to God and the Holy Spirit. We must understand in 2 Corinthians 5:14 that Christ Jesus judges us and our hearts daily, so we do not want to damage ourselves by continuing to lead ourselves down the path of unrighteousness by being for ourselves. I continue to say we need to get our minds and stop living in the Old Testament like how it was before Christ Jesus died for our sins. Homeless men and women do this at homeless shelters by worshiping God at chapel services daily and live by the flesh and world outside of chapel services at homeless shelters. I saw it happen among clients at Star of Hope Mission in Houston outside of chapel services daily last year.

Homeless people at homeless shelters need to change and need to set boundaries for themselves. Homeless men and women rather live in the flesh and not serve God. When I was staying at star of Hope Mission in Houston, many homeless men in the program left the shelter because they did not live under boundaries and new standards for themselves. Homeless men that left Star of Hope Mission in Houston because they do not want to go through the transformation to worship and serve God. Homeless men and women do not want to live at homeless shelters to set boundaries and transform themselves for God. I disagree with homeless shelters staff at some homeless shelters today that do not offer chapel services and biblical counseling. Homeless shelters need more spiritual classes, biblical counseling and chapel services because homeless men and women need to set boundaries and standards to set for themselves spiritually. I believe homeless men and women are afraid of the challenge to transform them to live for God and the Holy spirit.

Sinners and people that do not go to church thinking they know more than we do. As a Christian and disciple, we are powerful servants and disciples of God in our hearts and minds. We serve God and obedience to God. Homeless men and women need to change and want to change themselves. As Bishop and senior Pastor, I have seen people that do not want to go to church and worship God are dealing with loneliness, bitterness, anger and mental health. People that do not go to church need to make a change and set boundaries for themselves in their life to be obedient to God and Holy Spirit in their life. People need to stop envy and hating others , including church going and spiritual people. When I think about the 12 Step Classes at Star of Hope Mission in Houston, it is classes that teach clients to transform themselves to God and set spiritual boundaries for themselves. It is a good process for Star of Hope Mission in Houston

to encourage people to be open for themselves to start transformation for themselves to start serving God in their life. I disagree that homeless shelters do not offer this process and want people to go to church on their own. We, as Christians and disciples need to force religion and obedience to God at homeless shelters. Many people at homeless shelters that are wicked need Christ Jesus in their life.
