I want to say to you a story about widows because to make it clear what is Godly stuff to do a widow. If you are married to one spouse your whole life, it is okay to be remarried to someone else. It is okay for person over sixty years of age to be marry again along they are married to one man and/or woman their whole life. It was no Adam and Steve before Adam and Eve. Some sex couples and LGBT community do not count in this sermon because some sex marriage and homosexuality is not part of God Plan. It is domination from the Lord.

1 Timothy 5:9-

1 Timothy 5:10

Only widows are allowed to be remarried that have strong faith and good workmanship to God. People remarry without strong faith and workmanship to God and faith in God is leading down the path of satan kingdom. Only widows are allowed to be married again is single parents raising children spiritually on their own, help the poor and homeless, do good for other people with sharing and teaching about God to others, followed God plan all through their life from the time they were born again. In order to follow God word as a widow, you must not marry a younger widow to replace your deceased spouse that were maybe near your age. For example, do not marry someone that is 20 years

range. Then you do not remarry anyone if you are ⁴⁰⁻⁵⁰ ~~in your 30s~~ years of age that is 25-30 years of age. If you are going to remarry, remarry someone in your generation. Remarry a widow that is strong in Christ and have strong faith in God. When a Christian remarry, they must be married to one man or woman. My grandmother living today in Chicago will be allowed to remarry if she chooses to by her being near 90 years old. My grandmother has been faithful all her life to God and Holy Spirit. If my biological father's mother is living today, she will be allowed to remarry if she chooses to because she was righteous to God and spiritual person.

Timothy 5:13

Widows righteous and spiritual to God is not all about gossiping about others and acting like busybodies like. Paul explained in Matthew when he was speaking to Timothy. All churches and ministries need disciples like disciples Timothy to educate us on God's covenant about law on widows on how they continue to be righteous to God and Holy Spirit. Paul was educating Timothy when he urged him while he was traveling to Macedonia. Paul wanted to help Timothy understand the law for widows under God's covenant to be righteous and humble to God and Holy Spirit as widows. Paul was educating and teaching disciple Timothy about how widows should live as a humble and spiritual to God.

How can churches can relieve widows?

My aunt on my biological father's side of family is ^{not} allowed to remarry under God's covenant because she was married twice and not married to one man. It was a heinous and committed sin in her life as a baptized Christian and disciple. She will be judged in heaven after she dies on earth. Church can start by providing relief to widows by helping them out financially and economically dealing with joblessness and poverty, loss of a spouse or friend or family member. That's why church provides sick and shut-in and bereavement to families.

Timothy 5:9-16 (Read)

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How churches can help widows?

1. Help widows in the time of need with burial and funeral arrangements
2. Help widows with memorial service arrangements
3. Pray for widows for healing and mourning of lost loved ones
4. Help families of widows out economically and financially
5. Churches need to offer support for their ~~old~~^{widow} members that lost close friends and loved ones
