When we read Proverbs 34:11, the first thing we need to think about is how Christ Jesus wants us to seek God and listen to him daily while on earth. The devil still wants to control our minds, so we can lie, do evil, steal, kill and listen to sinful worlds and idolatry. When I read Proverbs 34:14, I am righteous most of the time and 97% spiritual because I still need to work on some tribulations in my life as a bishop and man of God. The church needs to raise \$5,000 from members and community for church operations in Brooklyn, such as pay for salaries and wages of staff, homelessness and social services programs. The Board of Directors for the church is 66% filled for church operations while the church is working to headquarter operations in Brooklyn. The Church has registered its annual report early this year for 2024 in the State of Michigan. The church will do the same before October 1, 2025. That's why the church annual report has 2024 on it because Michigan licensing has it backwards. It means when the church files its annual report for 2025 it will have 2025 on its documents and good standing certificate in Michigan. I want to say soon that the church can start receiving tithes and offerings in Brooklyn by mail at 77 Sands Street in Brooklyn, NY starting next month.
