Never Let Yourself Fall Short to Glory of God, Part III

1. We need to be teachers of the word to unbelievers.
2. We need to serve God as disciples to encourage others to seek God.
3. We need to seek God as our source and master.
4. If you are homeless living at a homeless shelter, you want to be fed the word to live a new life in Christ. Homeless men and women fear living for God and turning your life over to God. That's why homeless men and women do not want to go to homeless shelters to turn their life over to Christ because they fear living for God and living in righteousness.
5. You need to stay at homeless shelters to understand living for God is the key to living in the path of righteousness to heaven. Homeless men and women need God to allow us to live a prosperous life the right way, not by the world. We need to understand living by 1 John 2:15-17 is not the answer.
6. Homeless men and women need to learn how to turn away from temptation and not be tempted by others and the world to live in sin. People rush to get out of homeless shelters without letting God really bless them is only caring about temptation, sin and conceit. Do not rush to leave homeless shelters. Homeless men and women need to let God work through you. God has worked in me while I was in the Spiritual Recovery Program at Star of Hope Mission in Houston.
7. Let God help you plan your goals long-term to better position yourself spiritually when you are at the point like I did on February 1, 2024. I know in my heart and for God I was ready to leave Star of Hope Mission in Houston by God blessing me like he is doing right now in Philadelphia.
8. Encourage homeless men and women to go to a homeless shelter to help themselves by not giving them money every time you see them. When you see homeless men and women on the streets asking for money for food, you need to be encouraged to stay at a homeless shelter to search your heart to find themselves and seek God in their life. God can open doors for them and help them seek God in their life while here on earth. God can open doors for them with faith and obedience to God. It is homeless men and women in this situation are members of my congregation and they are doing well spiritually because I mentored them in the bible. God can provide homeless men and women on the streets with breakthroughs. They do not want to continue to live in the sinful world dealing with sin and food insecurity and sleeping outside in the cold when the temperature drops at night. Homeless men and women need to understand homeless shelters are services for them funded by cities and state governments.
9. Read the Book of Galatians to be trained and become a better Christian with the fruit of the spirit.

10. Living in a homeless shelter will help you improve yourself spiritually and stop living in bondage and temptation. Homeless shelters can teach you how to live the right way by not being afraid to live by boundaries and rules including living by boundaries and rules from a homeless shelter. Homeless men and women can stop living in depression and oppression. Homeless men and women need to around people that will strengthen and show you support spiritually for your trials and tribulations. Sinful world today will drag homeless men and women down to sin, unrighteousness, temptation and evil.
11. Homeless shelters can help you reshape and improve their character for God.
12. Find a loyal church home while staying at a homeless shelter to strengthen your faith in God and the Holy Spirit.
