

**Title:** The Legacy Blueprint: Stewarding the Domestic Church

**Scriptural Anchor:** "If anyone does not know how to manage his own household, how will he care for God Church?"-1 Timothy 3:5

### I. The Order of Operations

In the Memphis restoration, we do not sacrifice the family on the altar of church success. Your first congregation is your spouse and children.

- **The Domestic Pulpit:** Your dining table and household is your primary altar.

- **The Family Council:** Sit down this week and audit your home ledger. Are you spending more time on the public signal than on your private relationships?
- **The Domestic Peace Protocol:** Remove the thuggish language and chaos from your home. Replacing it will make the director.
