Board of Trustees members will have a busy schedule during church transition to Georgia next month. I support some issues in Republican Party, such as Balance Budget amendment to control government spending, lower and less taxes for Americans, reduce taxes for small businesses to be able to hire more Americans for jobs and raise wages, stronger defense and win global war on terrorism, no abortion and same-sex marriage, making it easier for Americans to have access to public services in their communities with nonprofit organizations and businesses. My 100-Day Agenda in 2021

- I used to live in Georgia in spring 2020, but moved to the Midwest because I was not in a good financial position to live in Georgia at the time. Based on the Board of Trustees vote this month, I will have no choice to move back to Georgia at the end of next month. Landlord in Birmingham always was informed about the church transition and had to move to Georgia. The First Lady and I are more financially capable to live in Atlanta today than in spring 2020. People told me this week that I should consider postponing public speeches and sermons until February 2020. Board of Trustees members say it is wasted money for me to travel with first Lady Jennifer to Georgia every week. The Subcommittee on Church Ethics has audited the first Lady and I personal finances and cash flow this year. Members say we are able to move and live in Georgia permanently in our home in Atlanta. Landlord in Birmingham knows about me moving to Georgia on January 29, 2021 permanently through retirement. I already informed the landlords here in Birmingham on December 20, 2020 and will be able to receive security deposit before January 29, 2021.
- Become a volunteer at Atlanta Mission next summer to serve and help the homeless with church staff. I can expand my cheerful giving to Atlanta to help the homeless on the streets of Chicago. It was \$10,653 of personal donation made to homeless men and women in Chicago based on personal tax returns and receipts.
- Continue dialogue and outreach with Atlanta City Council and mayor office because I strongly supported Keisha Lance Bottoms for mayor and win her election. In Spring 2020, I talked and met with lawmakers at their offices about church/congregation outreach to help the homeless and low-income communities since 2014. I had a friendly connection and discussion with Georgia state lawmakers in Democratic and Republican Party about our church work to help the homeless and low-income Americans in Illinois, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Georgia, South Carolina, Ohio, Iowa, New York, Michigan and Kentucky. I told Georgia state lawmakers that my congregation and myself came a long way to my success because my congregation started out with less members in 2014. We continue to grow as a congregation and get larger year after year.
- My executive office will prepare plans and groundwork for Homelessness First Initiative to be successful to get homeless men and women out of poverty long-term. We will start to provide food and supplies to homeless men and women in Atlanta dealing with food insecurity and poverty at homeless shelters and on the streets in the Atlanta area along with partnering with other organizations in Atlanta that help the homeless on a daily and weekly basis. Church plans to provide food and supplies to 250-300 homeless men and women in Atlanta in the first three months of 2021. I will sign Homelessness First Initiative in my office in Atlanta when it comes to my desk.
- Provide Board meetings to prepare rollout of social services for homeless people and low-income Americans in low-income communities in Atlanta. I will receive briefings from the Board of Trustees as well as the Bylaws and Rules Committee.
- Make sure communications team update the website with new church location in Atlanta, new and updated bylaws, leadership, final 2020 Annual report
