II. Announcements

- Bylaws and Rules Committee members pass the 2026 Budget with a vote 11-8 with changes by amendments from other members. The 2026 Budget has to go back to the Vision Keepers to vote on the changed version of the 2026 Budget. The budget structures the church operations and community outreach programs that help the needy and homeless in Oakland County, Michigan. The budget is \$2.7 million with a \$40,000 budget surplus throughout next year. Vision Keepers plan to vote on the budget this Friday in Flint.
- Vision Keepers is moving forward with the healthcare package that will be \$820,000 in 2026 to provide healthcare for church employees. They will determine what healthcare to have for church employees, such as ICHRA, ACA PPO or HMO type healthcare.
- Bishop Nicolas Hobson plans to schedule a meeting with Homelessness Prevention Review Board members to discuss the cost of living and poverty in Oakland County to help families in the county living in homelessness and poverty.
