that do have vision in their life are serving God for a venue to heaven. They need to thank God for their vision and change their venue for heaven. Turn to the person next to you and say thank you for changing my venue to heaven. We need to change our venue and vision for God for preparations for anything that happens in your life and life on earth that affects earth and human life. When we go out to wild parties and clubs to find a soulmate and friends, it is time to change your venue to God. When you have been getting your possessions and needs from the world, it is time to change your venue to God. When you have been depending on the world as your source, it is time to change your venue to God. When you are sick at home during the week including Sunday, it is time to change your venue to God to find a church home to attend bible study and Sunday services. When you are getting tired of your life feeling like it is running into a wall, it is time to change your venue to God. When you catch yourself making friends with sinners and wickedness friends, it is time to change your venue to God and find friends at spiritual and fellowship gatherings. When you are tired of being an underachiever and not getting things good out of life, it is time to change your venue to God to avoid mental health and depression. When you are tired of not being part of your children's life as a parent, it is time to change your venue to God to ask God to guide you to start being part of your children and families to avoid family separations and living in different residences or places of living in the United States of America. When you see yourself tired of being homeless or dealing with homelessness, it is time to change your venue to God by inviting family back into your life. When you are tired of being a taker conformed to the world, it is time to change your venue to God to ask God you during your tribulations. When you see your current goals and accomplishments not working for you in your life to succeed, it is time to change your venue to God. I am so blessed to God's kingdom even during tribulations because I changed my venue to heaven in 2011. In 2 Corinthians 5:1-10, Paul were speaking to the church of believers in Corinth when he served for Jesus to explain to the church of Corinth the need for change in venue to heaven and honor God that died for our sins and rose again, trust God as rock of our salvation, have a sound mind for God as rock of our salvation, well-known with our minds and hearts, taking risks to serve God as rock of your salvation, being absent from the body and world, walking the Christian walk towards God. Also, I have been using my knowledge from Star of Hope Mission in Houston in Spiritual Recovery Program and TLC on my monthly budget like I did and had to submit each month to staff. I used what I learned from Financial Management class at level 4-5 at Star of Hope Mission in Houston in the Spiritual Recovery Program on financial management and set up an emergency fund. The Subcommittee for Church Ethics gets my signed monthly budgets each month for the next month. I do not do budgets for the same month. I do my budgets for the next month because it is how I learned to do it at Star of Hope Mission in Houston in Spiritual Recovery Program and TLC after October 2023 commencement. The Subcommittee on Church Ethics prepares a final report to the church members and public at the end of the year on income and personal finances before tax season.

Mark 14:58 talks about the resurrection of Jesus when he rose after he was crucified and hung on the cross, then he died on the cross for our sins. The scripture says he rose on the third day and built a temple without his hands. Read and familiarize yourself with Romans 14:10, Romans 12:11, Romans 13:1, Romans 12:29. When I read 2 Corinthians 1:16, I think about some friends I grew up with who act like fools and accept them as fools and pray for them over and over again to eliminate their foolishness. It is like Jesus changed his venue when he sacrificed himself to die for our sins during the resurrection.
