

Do Not Be Mammon-Driven, Have Vision to God Kingdom-Part 4

Church 2024 Theme and Series: John 10:9-16

Ecclesiastes 5:3-18

- A dream comes when there are many cares, and many words mark the speech of a fool (3).
- When you make a vow to God, do not delay to fulfill it. He has no pleasure in fools, fulfill your vow (4).
- It is not better not to make a vow than to make one and not to fulfill it (5).
- Do not let your mouth lead you into sin. and , do not protest to the temple messenger, my vow was a mistake. Why should God be angry at what you say and destroy the work of your hands? (6)
- Much dreaming and many words are meaningless. Therefore, fear God (7).
- If you see poor oppressed in the district, and justice and rights denied, do not be surprised at such things; for one official is eyed by higher still (8).

Ecclesiastes 5:3-18

- The increase from the land is taken is taken by all; the king himself profits from the fields (9).
- Whoever has money never has enough; whoever loves wealth is never satisfied with their income. This too is meaningless (10).
- As goods increase, so do those who consume them. And what benefit are they to the owners except to feast their eyes on them? (11)
- The sleep of the laborer is sweet, whether they eat little or much, but as for the rich, their abundance permits them with no sleep (12).
- I have never seen a grievous evil under the sun: wealth hoarded to the harm of its owners, or wealth lost through some misfortune, so that when they have children there is nothing left for them to inherit (13-14).
- Everyone comes naked from the mother womb, and as everyone comes, so they depart. They take nothing from their toll that they can carry in their hands (15).

Ecclesiastes 5:3-18

- This is too a grievous evil: as everyone comes, so they depart, and what do they gain, since they toil for the wind? (16)
- All their days they eat in darkness, with great frustration, affliction and anger (17).
