HOMELESSNESS ACCESS TO JOBS IN CHICAGO

Pastor Hobson will talk more about the free service the church will offer for the homelessness in Chicago. The church is thinking about implementing a phone service for the homeless to help them get jobs. When homelessness in Chicago fill out job applications, they look unpresentable and get discriminated behind closed doors. That needs to change for homelessness nationwide and in Chicago. Pastor Hobson is passionate to helping homelessness in this country and in Chicago get back on their feet. Homeless families should not have to live in a shelter. Single parents should not have live and raise children in a shelter. Homelessness in Chicago need to budget their money and know how to invest it wisely. Pastor Hobson is passionate about reducing the homelessness capacity at Pacific Garden Mission, Olive Branch Mission, Franciscan Outreach Association, A Little Bit of Heaven, Interfaith House and House of Prayer in Douglass Park area. Pastor Hobson apologized for alienating Muslims and called them bad people, but Muslims should not have to live in shelters either. Muslims deserve the same opportunities as other Americans in this country. Homelessness Phone service will be managed by the Pastoral Care Ministry and will accept calls of job offers and interviews for homeless people in Chicago. Pastoral Care Ministry will help homeless people get professional clothing for the job interview or job. Pastoral Care Ministry will help homeless people get the jobs by not letting them take their luggage suitcases or bags in the interview with them. Homeless people will be allowed to keep their luggage and at the church administrative office location on the day of the interview. Church is currently raising money for its social service and church operations to make a difference and provide real change to low-income communities. it is time for the rich to pay their fair share in taxes and time to bailout the 99%. It is time to provide income equality and job security in the economy to all Americans.
