Guide us through our tribulations and trials daily while you see people dealing with poverty and homelessness

Let us continue to give you glory and praise to your name daily to strengthen our hearts as they grow like a mustard seed.

I will talk about Psalm 73:6, 2 Corinthians 12:9, Hebrews 12:2, Psalm 121:8, Proverbs 16:3, Psalm 28:7, Isaiah 56:11, 1 Peter 1:18-21, Matthew 19:26, 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17. First, I will talk about Psalm 73:6. When we read Psalm 73:6, we need to try to maintain our love and obedience towards Christ because we need to be careful not to be tempted by the world to provide any type of violence and wickedness in our life. We must maintain our life for Christ by staying away from making decisions by conceit and selfish ambitions. It is like it says in Psalm 73:6, we must not use conceit and pride like a necklace to listen to idolatry and the world. In these tough and bad economic times while people are being squeezed and dealing with inflation, we must call and depend on God from above. That's why I continue to say we must pray day and night to our personal savior Christ Jesus from the throne in heaven. Say to the person next to you: remain distant from temptation. Do not use violence in our life in your household and inner circle. We need to stop the violence between Israel and Palestinian protect to find a way to gain some common ground to be peaceful. I want to say both Palestine and Israel need to be free from their country's dictatorship, so the Palestinians and people in Israel can live peaceful lives.

1. Trust God as your strength when you make any decisions that will impact your life.
2. Trust God as your strength when we use our freewill that God gave us
3. Trust God as your strength to avoid ourselves living like a sinner and/or tax collector.
4. Trust God as your strength before we support and perform any fornication and/or lust.
5. Trust God as your shield on a daily basis that can protect you from enemies and evil around you.
6. Trust God as your strength that is the only one that can bless and provide you with a breakthrough along as you are living in the path of righteousness to God under his grace and mercy.

7. Trust God by continuing to read the Book of Galatians to train yourself to live as a disciple and with the fruit of the spirit.

While you are doing the list of things and living righteous to God, your heart will rejoice and continue to grow like a mustard seed. It is a good thing because your faith is growing like a mustard seed to maintain your spot in heaven and in the Most Holy Place in the Tabernacle. Say to the person next to you: stay strong living under God's grace. Say to the person on the other side of you: continue to rejoice God to remain strong under God's grace. 2 Corinthians 12:9 is another scripture to read to maintain strength for Christ Jesus and keep Jesus at the center of your life. When we read Hebrews 12:2, this is the time to rely on Jesus in the scripture. We do not need to be relying on the world and idolatry. I want to tell a true story about what I mentioned in the recent video about my anniversary for being admitted at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston. I learned how to let God guide me and rely on God as my source to stop making life decisions too fast and quickly that always affect me economically and financially in a negative way. My quick decisions put me in places like Star of Hope Mission in Houston, Atlanta Mission, Pacific Garden Mission, Olive Branch Mission, A Little Bit of Heaven Shelter, Detroit Rescue Mission, Catholic Worker House in Dubuque. Star of Hope Mission in Houston was the only program that was able to help me with my conceit, selfish ambitions and letting God guide me in my decisions.

We must have strong workmanship to God to commit ourselves to the kingdom. This is the only way to maintain ourselves and our strength to God. We need to try to play Russian roulette with ourselves around the brazen altar to get to the Most Holy Place in the Tabernacle. This is what we hear from other pastors preaching to their congregation is resting while God is working in our life. Do not focus on working and not resting in your life. When the other pastor and I say that we do more working and not resting, God will not work for us. That is 100% fact. We need to keep Proverbs 16:3 in the center of our minds daily to keep us focused to maintain ourselves under God's grace.

Take notes on this because you need to remember this and to stay maintained to God during your christian journey to the kingdom:

1. Trust and stay away from greed because God is your source and provider.
2. Read the Book of Galatians daily to train yourself how to live for God under his grace.
3. Read and understand the bible and Book of Galatians. Galatians is my favorite book of the bible because it trains us on how to live with the fruit of the spirit and how to live righteous to God.
4. Trust God and continue up to heaven the righteous way. Stop being all about yourself as a taker and acting selfish.
5. Read and understand 1 Peter 1:18-20.

What Matthew 19:26 is saying is that everything is possible to God as long as you have faith in Christ Jesus and his kingdom. It is time for all of us to put our faith in God to grow our hearts like a mustard seed, not put our trust in man and the world. We need to put in the center of our minds and say God is able. It is true that God is able to do good things in our life to keep us on that path of righteousness to the kingdom. We must fight everyday to keep us on that path of righteousness and understand that God can make every good thing and good accomplishment possible in our life on earth.

God's grace=hope in our life is what we want to achieve through God's kingdom.

God grace=love for God daily while we live obedient to the kingdom.

God grace=honor what God did for us during the resurrection

God grace+good works and workmanship for God
