When I was still in high school, my godmother's son told my mother that he was going to look out for me while I entered my freshman year of high school. He told my mother that he wants to make sure that I do not end up being friends with the wrong crowd. When I was in high school, I did not have to worry about making a lot of friends. When I graduated from Esmond Elementary School, I graduated with a lot of people that I ended up going to Morgan Park High School with. When I was at Esmond Elementary School, I did make friends with people in the class with me and when I was in Ms. Rounds Science class. I want to say my best friends at Esmond Elementary School were Deangelo Tolbert and Kenneth Eddington. After my freshman year of high school, I did not have to make a lot of friends either because many people graduated from Esmond Elementary school the next year after me attended Morgan Park High School. When I was in freshman and Sophomore year of high school, 99% of the people in my classes and in school that I already knew from Esmond Elementary School on the southside of Chicago. When I was in my Junior year of high school at Morgan Park High School in Chicago, 97% of the people in school that I was already friends with from my time at Esmond Elementary School. I am friends with people at the time I attended Fort Dearborn Elementary School before I transferred to Esmond Elementary School in Chicago. I want to tell a true story about my time in high school when I was making friends with people. I did have people in elementary and high school that used to be friends with me. I mean used me in a way to buy friendship. I learned in elementary school about friendship and making friends with people. My teachers always told me that people try to earn friends with respect and dignity, not buy friends in a way that starts an altercation and conflicts with other people.

One of the things that I think I can learn from my struggles going back to 2011, it had to still do with any sins in my life. I turned my life over to God and the Holy Spirit by being baptized and born again on September 4, 2011. I want to be an example to become a saved christian and disciple by being baptized and born again. Since I got saved and sought God in my life the friendly churches I attended were in Indiana, Texas, Michigan, Ohio, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Iowa and Maryland. After I seek God in my life and live obedient to God, I started to use good contentment and judgement from God's kingdom to start creating new disciples for myself to build my inner circle. I started out with twelve disciples in 2011

to 59+ disciples today. I started serving God in my life under the Great Commission. When I talk about the violence and crime in Chicago, residents lack serving God under the Great Commission by building an inner circle for ourselves to help us live humble to God, living for God with obedience, cut out wickedness in our life, positive and happy, end any sin and adultery, stop listening and living by temptation and idolatry. After I became a christian and disciple in 2011, I started to spread the Gospel and my faith in God got stronger to serve God and his kingdom under his grace. As a man of God and Bishop, I have let people come to me that want to become friends. I let God in every step of the way to help me meet new people and become friends with positive, spiritual and good people. I have been making friends with people that appreciate my hard work and serving communities spiritually. I want to be truthful about Salem Baptist Church of Chicago, Pastor James Meeks and Pastor Dearel Jordan that I never got the high recognition from them that all pastors are supposed to give their members as motivated and committed individuals to serve God and communities as a Christian and disciples. My congregation right now is doing better than Salem Baptist Church of Chicago because I am a more welcoming congregation with growing attendance and people told me that I do not want to prove myself and my success. My congregation started small and continuously growing weekly today when myself, guests and staff preach in the pulpit during services. I got some resistance from Pastor Corey Brooks as well when he did not want to work with my congregation on ending crime, homelessness and poverty in Chicago. I still have respect for Pastor Meeks, Pastor Corey Brooks and Pastor Dearel Jordan; but I feel like today that I got a resistance that I did not deserve. I witnessed the same resistance from Pastor Barclay from Progressive Beulah Pentecostal Church as well and did not get the support from him either, but I still respect him and do not hate him. In 2015, I got feedback from Chicago residents that I have the spiritual gift to serve the community to be a problem solver and make a difference. People like Pastor James Meeks, Pastor Corey Brooks, Pastor Thomas Barclay and some other pastors do not see that today and like they did back when I lived in Chicago that I have the spiritual gifts and motivation to serve God and community. It is like I get more recognition about my spiritual gifts to serve God and communities from churches and organizations in Georgia, Texas, New York, Ohio, Iowa, Michigan, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and African countries abroad. 99.9% of the time I live my life with heavenly wisdom and continue to turn from earthly wisdom. I will be preaching during my 14th year anniversary service later this month in the pulpit to the members and the congregation.
