Missions and Homeless Shelters Case Study

- **The Observation:** Why do facilities hot or lax?
- **The Leak:** it is about letting outside food past the staff, 18-24 not following rules of the facility, too many people with anger issues, too many envy and homeless people that act like spectators and haters. Too many homeless people confidence-paralyzed. When the standard things are compromised in small things. The structure collapses in large things.
- **Extraction:** A Diligent member do not sit in the heat. He finds the sanctuary or marketplace.

The Southaven Shift

- **The Border Crossing:** Diligence moved the Lord Jesus Christ Center to Mississippi.
- We chose the charter that matches our frequency
- We have more engagements on social media because we are diligent as a congregation.
