- Strive to put needs of others before your own. My family members does this a lot and that why like to help the homeless. I care about putting their needs before my own. I am a cheerful giver and not a taker that love the world than God.
- Avoid pride and self-seeking. This was my weakness before Star of Hope Mission in Houston in the Spiritual Recovery Program in 2023. I learned to overcome this program after being in the program for five months. I learned how to depend on God and receive gifts from above the kingdom, not the world. I stay away from 1 John 2:15-17
- Love God and love your neighbor as you love yourself.
- Let love motivate my actions. For example, I let love love motivate my actions by helping the homeless and poor with my personal money like I did in the past. That's why I am moving back to NYC to let guide work in me there going forward. I care for the homelessness.
- Follow God teachings and commands in the bible
- Seek to align your will with God will
- Share your faith with others and help them know Jesus
- Live as a witness to your faith through your words and actions

My True Story and Testimony

When I was in the program at Passion Care in Baltimore, I felt like I did not want to be in that program and did not know if I wanted to stay in Baltimore or leave. My father and mother know that I never been in prison or jail. My parents know I do not have a criminal record and do not need to be friends with anybody. I did not want to be in the program because I knew that I did not belong there because I do not have substance abuse or drugs. I actually call clients in the program fake christians. That is a 100% fact. I say the program is a disgrace and do not need to exist anywhere including Baltimore. I like programs that are christian and biblical that talked about the bible, clients read the bible and have weekly bible study, and help clients live rights to God and his commandments to avoid relapsing and loving the sinful world.

I just got an email for my advisors in Detroit saying that 13 homeless people and ex-offenders just released from prison want me to be their sponsor to help them through recovery. They want They are live in Bronx and looking for a church home. They heard about the church and my track record for helping people with mental health and substance abuse stay off drugs and substance abuse for nearly 300+ days to get their life back on track the right way. I plan to host to support group with the men and women next weekend to talk about their substance abuse and mental health issues that have problems with. I am happy that I can get back to work in the NYC area and going back to where I started last summer in NYC last summer. I will share and have the other people tell their stories about how my sponsorship has helped them spiritually get back their life back on track the right way for them. They will share their stories in person and by satellite on zoom during the meeting.

Scripture in Context: Matthew 4:10

A careful who I am friends with and affiliate with on daily basis. I stay away from haters, instigators, sinners and people that think they know it all.
