- Laziness promise ease but delivers crushing cycle of poverty and failure.
- People quickly to quick, foolish, and illegal ways to satisfy their desires leading to trouble, consequences and incarceration.

Resolution:

- Everything is accomplished through hard work and commitment like I did with my higher education and got my calling to preach.
- Get a job and stop sitting around doing nothing living off the government, such as Medicaid, SSI/SSDI and SNAP benefits.
- Get out and volunteer at an organization, homeless shelters or small business to strengthen your work ethic.

The Path of the Diligent (The Hard Worker)


- Diligence is being focused, committed and persistent.

- Work is not a curse because it is a gift of calling that gives us dignity.
- We honor God when we use our hands to produce good things.

Foolishness and Lack of Vision

People who continuously get into trouble are foolish because they think about the immediate moment. They do not think about the consequences within five months and five years later. That why we need to teach our children to set realistic goals so they can live good life without being foolish, living in sin and learn how to stay out of trouble. The urgent need to quick money is temptation and blinds us to the consequences of being locked for years. w trade a moment of easy gratification for a lifetime of hard consequences.
