"Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened. You parents—if your children ask for a loaf of bread, do you give them a stone instead? Or if they ask for a fish, do you give them a snake? Of course not! So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask him."-Matthew 7:7-11

I want to tell you a true story about my Christian walk and faith in God. I want to tell you this story because Creflo Dollar said something in his sermon yesterday that was preaching my attention when he mentioned that the paycheck you get from your job is not your gift. You earn it. That is why I use my spiritual gifts in Shepherding, wisdom, teaching, prophecy, knowledge and exhortation to give it to the poor and homelessness in Chicago, Detroit and Atlanta. I was blessed to have a second job at a temp agency in the past, but I understood that it is not a gift.

Also, I want to tell you that prayer is powerful because it is time that God heard my prayers over and over again. That's why I say Star of Hope Mission in Houston was the better homeless shelter that helped me economically and spiritually. My case manager gave people like me on his caseload last year listening to prayer logs each month. I want to say case managers and staff as mental health shelters are bad homeless shelters in this nation because they think forcing religion at their facility is a bad thing. I have completed all my prayer listening logs at Star of Hope Mission in Houston while I was on the Spiritual Recovery Program. God and Christ Jesus actually speak to me because God is in me as a follower of Jesus. I always notice that God is my prayers and gives me blessings in my life. If you are homeless at a homeless shelter like Delta Manor homeless shelter, you do not need to pay staff at those homeless shelters, no mind when you are spiritual and think you are crazy and the spirit speaks to you. I call staff and case managers at mental health shelters and Delta Manor homeless shelter in the Bronx dumb founded people. I am being 100% on that and they need to let people that are spiritual and follower of Christ Jesus guide Christian and disciples in their life. Case Managers at mental health shelters like Delta Manor homeless shelter represent providing false witness against others thinking they know everything about people. That is why my legal team says that mental health homeless shelters like Delta Manor in the Bronx are one of the homeless shelters on the list of homeless shelters part of that nationwide investigation from my legal team working with the US Department of Justice and FBI. Case Managers at mental health homeless shelters like Delta Manor in the Bronx need to leave Christians and disciples alone and let God Guide people in

their life in the path of righteousness. I am telling you the truth about what the NYPD says shelters in the Bronx are bad. During the investigation against shelters like Delta Manor homeless shelter in the Bronx, my legal team will start an advocacy group for homeless shelters to address concerns about homeless shelters like Delta Manor homeless shelter in the Bronx. Case managers at homeless shelters like Delta Manor homeless shelter try to take away your guidance as a Christian and disciples from God and heaven. I want to say if you are homeless and need emergency housing in the New York City area, the Delta Manor homeless shelter is not the homeless shelter to be. That is 100% fact. That is all the truth I will say about the homeless shelter in the Bronx named Delta Manor homeless shelter. Delta Manager homeless shelters think people are crazy including people that are christian and disciples that let God from the throne from heaven and the spirit speaks to them according to sources. Delta Manot homeless shelter deserves to be put out of business forever. I hope that happens with this investigation from my legal team. The Director at Delta Manor homeless shelters and case managers at the homeless shelter think they know everything about clients by assuming everything. That is 100% fact.

Turn to the person next to you and say it is power in prayer. I know that prayer is powerful for me because I remember I was a teenager and I was in my room praying to God on my knees. I strongly believe at the time God heard me based on the positive results during that day. When I first God saved and was born again on September 4, 2011; I was told by a deacon to keep record on how many times God heard my prayers and how many times God praised me to answer my prayers. Based on my results I have prayed to God 80+ since 2011 for my needs and praised me 68 times based on my prayers for my needs. As a christian and disciples, we need to be patient when we pray to God for our needs from the throne in heaven. When I pray to God daily or weekly, I keep on asking God for my needs while being patient with him at the throne in heaven. Turn to the person next to you and say be patient with prayer after you pray to God. Turn to the person on the other side of you and say God blessings, mercy and breakthroughs are real. As a christian and disciple. I do what the scripture says in Matthew 7:7 by praying for what I ask for from God until I get it. When I read this scripture, I think about what has been said about Delta Manor homeless shelter in the Bronx: that the staff are so sinful that they want clients not to be Godly and get everything from the sinful world. Saying to the person next to you Delta Manor homeless shelter is bad. When you pray to God for your needs, you have to have strong faith in God in order to receive praise and blessings from God at the throne in heaven like it says in Matthew 7:8.

When I was young and a child, I always got good gifts from my parents and birthdays. I am thankful for those gifts. I am thankful for the gifts I got from my parents when I needed something like food and money. My mother and step-fathers are sinners because they did not want to help me out financially with an outside student loan to pay for my higher education at DePaul University, so I have to live out homeless shelters in Chicago to pursue my degrees and higher education. When I read Matthew 7:11, think about times I needed money from my mother and stepfather. In the past they never gave it to me and my stepfather has money in his savings account according to sources and people like me rather have me live in the struggle. Some changes are being made to church Bylaws and websites. It means the Community Empowerment and Support Workshop will be moving to Detroit next month. I am leaving New York on August 28, 2024 to carpool with them to Detroit. We need to stop relying on elections and support the government to bail us out economically and spiritually. We need to build our prayer life and start praying to God at the throne in heaven God what we need in our life. If you need to strengthen your personal finances, God will come through for you to strengthen your personal finances. If you need to

improve your well-being and get out of homelessness, you need to have faith in God to come through for you and provide you with the breakthrough to get your life back on track. Do not rely on case managers unless they are spiritual and pastor like my case manager at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston that can provide you with spiritual guidance and support. You do not want to believe and rely on case managers at places like Delta Manor homeless shelter in the Bronx because they are ungodly and wicked. You need to ask yourself this question if you are homeless: "Do you want a sinner or sinful case manager at a homeless shelter to get back on your feet? If your answer is no, you guess correctly. We need more homeless shelters in this nation like Star of Hope Mission in Houston and Bowery Mission because homeless people need to learn to be fruitful and grow in path of righteousness to God and Holy Spirit, so they won't relapse after they leave the homeless shelter in their permanent housing. Homeless shelters in the Bronx are bad according to feedback from some NYPD police officers. After I am gone from New York, I will continue to push for reforms at homeless shelters, such as hold homeless shelters accountable all about greed and want to hold clients in homeless shelters longer period of time, cut homeless shelters by 52% over ten years, strip homeless shelters of their 501(c)(3) status from the IRS, allow more homeless shelters to put in place religious curriculum so help more clients seek God and organizations can become more Christ-centered and biblical based organizations. I just got an email back stating the US Department of Housing and Urban Development plan to crackdown and be part of the investigation because staff at the agency say it's illegal what homeless shelters like Delta Manor is doing during their operations and need to be held accountable and have donations and start future funding cuts to their operations.

- 1. Let God speak to you through prayer daily when you read the bible
- 2. You must have had obedience and strong faith in God and the Holy Spirit.
- 3. Let doors from God be opened to you daily by letting God open doors for you.
- 4. Don't worry about anything that you need because God got you. If you are struggling economically and financially, do not depend on elections and the government to bail you out.
- 5. Thank God for what he has given you daily.
- 6. Live with peace with God daily.
- 7. Give yourself to prayer to build a strong prayer life.
- 8. Pray to God during every occasion.
- 9. Understand God is listening to your prayers daily.
- 10. Be joyful and faithful.

Church staff and advisors in my executive office in Detroit told me I need to get back to Detroit and Southeast Michigan. They told me to make decisions based on me. I remember clients used to tell me to think about and like what I explained in this sermon is that I strongly believe God at the throne wants me to travel back to Southeast Michigan or Chicago where I have a track record. So I will leave with my advisors on August 28, 2024 to go back to Detroit. I have a proven track record in Detroit and the church is fully structured legally in Detroit. According to church financial records, we have provided assistance to the homeless in Detroit since 2016. My advisors said today that my decision is set to leave on August 28 with them and meet them with my belongings in Brooklyn. That's why family and friends wanted me to run for mayor in Chicago in 2011.
