We need to not fall from the glory of God in these tough and bad economic times. We have a country right now that is not united and strongly divided. We have people in this country dealing with mental health, tribulations and trials while dealing with homelessness. Joe Biden and Kamala Harris are not doing anything about nothing. Joe Biden has failed as commander-in-chief. One of my top issues in the economy and housing as an independent/unaffiliated voter in Pennsylvania. You see anti-Israel protests on college campuses across the country. Jesus was misconstrued as a Jew according to the Bible, so we need to be a nation being united to support Israel. I supported moving our embassy to Jerusalem during the Trump administration. I continue to support and be pro-Israel. I am not Jewish, but I am pro-Israel. I do support the Palestinians to be free from Hamas and have more freedom like other countries like Israel. First, I will talk about Romans 3:23-24 because it is a key scripture to this sermon to grow our hearts like a mustard seed. When we read Romans 3:23-24, we need to continue to be cautious in our life to prevent us from sinning and head down the path of righteousness. If we catch ourselves making a wrong choice or decision in our life, we want to repent immediately and have hope in God for his forgiveness of our sinning.

1. Appoint someone to be your accountability person to prevent you from sinning and make sure you stay on the path of righteousness. Your accountability person can be in your inner circle that I preached about previously. It means choose one of your disciples to hold you accountable.

2. Appoint an accountable person that can keep you in line with God and make sure you live obedient to God and the Holy Spirit. It prevents you from playing russian roulette with yourself back and forth in the Tabernacle between Most Holy Place and Brazen altar in the Tabernacle.
3. Continuing to read God's word will prevent you from living in sin and sinning because God is speaking to you and reading the bible.
4. Make you appoint your twelve disciples that will continue to check up on you daily to see if you are living in the path of righteousness for God to maintain your place in the Most Holy Place in the Tabernacle. Your twelve disciples in your inner circle will make sure you are not sinning daily.
5. Read the Book of Galatians daily to help train us to be better Christians and disciples with the fruit of their spirit.
6. Do not let your bitterness make you fall to the glory of God.
7. Do not let your slander and cause you slander other people let you fall from the glory of God.
8. Do not fall to the glory of God by living in sin and lust.

If you believe in Christ Jesus as your personal savior, you know that we are supposed to be living under God's grace in the New Testament. We do not live in the Old Testament because we live under the New Testament. We do not live in the old testament with people that are all about themselves. Some people in this world are living their life under the new testament because you see people continue to live in sin, sinning on a daily basis with temptation, living by 1 John 2:15-17. We need to renew our minds and get our minds out of the New Testament forever while on earth. Say to the person next to you: renew your mind for God's Kingdom. God has saved us from sin when sacrificed his life to die for our sins during the Resurrection. We must understand God saved us from our sins with his life and blood during the resurrection. We were born on earth with sin, but we must not continue to live in sin and sinning in our life. We must ignore Muslims and atheists when they speak negatively about the sacrifice of Christ Jesus and the resurrection. Whatever they say is false about our God and Christ Jesus. That is 100% fact. Say to the person next to you: Muslims are liars.

When we read Ehesians 4:32, we must not fall short of the glory of God by not being compassionate to one another. When we continue to do evil and become enemies of other people we will not get to heaven and live eternal life. That's why I say in the past we must worry about our own destiny and stop being envious of other people on earth. For example, Black/African-Americans need to stop hating on people that they see in a suit and look professional. It was a good thing for Black/African-Americans back in the civil rights movement to wear suits because they always got high respect from people and looked like serious and professional people. When I was still living in Chicago at the time, some professional Black/African-Americans always asked why do you always see most black/African-Americans

dressing casually or wearing jeans and a t-shirt. Black/African-Americans were taken more seriously during the civil rights movement when they dressed up in a suit or fancy dress clothes. There are more children in the world today who are not compassionate because they do not respect their elders and talk with profanity like they grew up. That's why I say in the past that parents need to do their jobs and be better parents while children are young to teach them right from wrong. Parents need to raise children like people like me were young and born in the 1980s. People like myself grew up in the 1980s and lived in disciplined households that parents taught us right from wrong, teach us to be respectful and responsible, and respect their elders. Children and youth in the world today act lazy and irresponsible that like to be disrespectful towards others and gossip about everyone they see in public and private settings. Children and youth need to find themselves to seek God with a fruit of the spirit and humble heart for God's kingdom. When you and I read Ephesians 4:32, children and youth need to seek God to find themselves to become more humble and live with the fruit of the spirit. All children and youth in the world today need to repent from their sins and live in sin. Some homeless men and women need to apply Ephesians 4:32 to their life as well because they are disrespectful to others while dealing with mental health and their addictions like here in Philadelphia and elsewhere. All homeless men and women need to repent to apply Ephesians 4:32 to their life daily. Homeless men and women can easily fall short to the glory of God because their wicked ways with their mental health and addictions get in the way of seeking and glorifying God. When you read Ephesians 4:32, Paul was speaking to believers. When you are reading Colossians 1:14, I look and read the scripture that we need to honor and become obedient to, so we can avoid repeating our sins and mistakes of making righteous decisions in our life. For example, abortion is a sin and continues to be a sin while we continue to support it and have abortions. Same-sex marriage and continue to be LGBT is a sin if people continue to repeat it by supporting Pride Month and same-sex marriage, living on the DL as an LGBT individuals to have sex or survival sex with the same gender every time. Read and familiarize yourself with Romans 8:11 day and night to prevent yourself from falling to the glory of God. We need to read and understand key scripture Acts 20:28 to keep us from falling to the glory of God in our life.

When I said in my previous sermon to recruit your twelve disciples like Jesus did, you make sure you have people in your flock and inner circle that will look out and watch out for you to keep your strong fellowship to God and the Holy Spirit. Our twelve disciples must be shepherds to one another to care for one another, love one another and worship and fellowship with one another. As twelve disciples of your inner circle, all you all must be overseer of whatever is going on in your inner circle to prevent you from falling to the glory of God. I tell people to read and familiarize yourself with the Book of Galatians because I look at the book of Galatians to provide a clear vision for us to seek God and keep our glorification with God stronger while on earth. I tell people to read book of Galatians to get the better and necessary training to live their life with the fruit of the spirit and become stronger disciples to God kingdom.
