Business on Capitol Hill



Bishop Hobson visited offices of United States Senators on Capitol Hill, such as Shelby, Casey, Toomey, Isakson, Schumer and Sanders. He visited offices of some members of Congress, such as Mary Guy Scanlon (D-PA). He talked to staff about the following proposals from the congregation, such as Affordable Housing and Homelessness Prevention Act, Criminal Justice and Gun Control Act, and Protect Life and Prescription Drug Act.

When education proposal were presented to Congress in 2014-2015, the proposal explained raising Pell-Grants to \$7700/semester and expanding access to Pell-Grants for college students. Students can borrow less money in student loans from financial aid programs. When tenants complain about poor living conditions in apartments, maintenance people complain like they hate their jobs. Cash bail need reform cash bail for people that cannot afford bail, pay less cash bail. After Bishop Hobson left Capitol Hill, he visited Central Union Mission to meet and greet staff at the homeless shelter. Bishop Hobson talked about his support for Africa Fair Trade Agreement to open markets in Africa and help more people get out of extreme poverty.

Prayers and Preaching by Bishop Nicolas Hobson

Bishop Hobson preached to the congregation during the series: Reality of Righteousness. He started preaching on the series in June 2019. He preached on the following topics to the congregation: Having your Prayers Answered, Relationships and Friendships, Removing Signs of Deception and Removing Depression in your Life. Bishop Hobson provided speeches on programs and church operations, hardship in black communities, church monthly donations.
