Whoever conceals hatred with lying lips and spreads slander is a fool. Sin is not ended by multiplying words, but the prudent hold their tongues. With their mouth the godless destroy their neighbors, but through knowledge the righteous escape. A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy person keeps a secret. A perverse person stirs up conflict, and a gossip separates close friends. Whoever fosters love covers over an offense, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends. The words of gossip are like choice morsels; they go down to the inmost parts. The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit. Gossip betrays confidence; so avoid anyone who talks too much. Without wood a fire goes out; without a gossip a quarrel dies down. The lips of fools bring them strife, and their mouths invite a beating. The mouths of fools are their undoing, and their lips are a snare to their very lives.

Psalms 34:13, 41:7, 141:3

Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from telling lies. All my enemies whisper together against me; they imagine the worst for me, saying an evil device, saying they cleave fast unto him: and now that he lieth he shall rise up no more. Set a guard over my mouth, Lord; keep

watch over the door of my lips.

1 Timothy 5:13-14, 3:9-11

Besides, they get into the habit of being idle and going about from house to house. And not only do they become idlers, but also busybodies who talk nonsense, saying things they ought not to. So I counsel younger widows to marry, to have children, to manage their homes and to give the enemy no opportunity for slander. They keep hold on deep truths of the faith with clear conscience. They must first be tested; and then if there is nothing against them, let them serve as deacons. In the same way, the women are to be worthy of respect, malicious talkers but temperate.

Romans 1:29-32

They have become filled with every kind of wickedness, evil, greed and depravity. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit and malice. They are gossips, slanderers, god haters, insolent, arrogant and boastful; they invent ways of doing evil; they disobey their parents; they have no understanding, no fidelity, no love, no mercy. Although they know God righteous decree that those who do such things deserve death, not only continue to do these very things but also approve of those who practice them.

Titus 2:2-5

Teach the older man to be temperate, worthy of respect, self-controlled, and sound in faith, in love and endurance. Likewise, teach the older woman to be reverent in the way they live, not to be slanderers or addicted to much wine, but to teach what is good. Then they can urge the younger women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God.
