"So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.-Galatians 6:9-10 (NLT)

I want to tell you a true story about people in the Bronx and New Yorkers today. You may run into people anywhere like me today that is trying to discourage me from what I need to do in my life. I want to explain to you that those people that are causing discouragement in your life is causing you to sin and not live up to what God has put forward in your life It is the same people that telling us on earth that are sinners and want us to live in sin with weak contentment and cause us to unsure of ourselves. Tell the person next to you and say do not be discouraged and remain strong in the Lord what you do. It is like what Pastor John Johnson said at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston after I commenced from the Spiritual Recovery Program. I remembered from him about lectures on vision. People that like to discourage you in your life want you to continue to go through life with sin and pain. Turn to the person next to you and say I want God to help me with my vision. Turn to the person on the other side of you and say I want God to guide me to my vision in my life. I am preaching in my favorite book of the Bible because I always explain that the book of Galatians teaches us how to live with the fruit of the spirit and train us to be better Christians and disciples. When I think about this scripture in recent days through prayers, I have made the right choice with the pros and cons to move back to Detroit on August 28, 2024. I say to you that I will not let no one discourage me for what I need to do that is right. It is like my case manager at Star of Hope Mission in Houston told me during our meetings that it is not a good idea to have weak contentment. He explained to me as a man of God and christian person like himself told me that being unsure of ourselves is ungodly. I decided to just retire and grow old in Southeast Michigan. I am not saying that as a bad thing. I like case managers at Star of Hope Mission in Houston including my own at the time last year because they are more godly and spiritual people that are worth listening to more. I rather listen and keep in touch with people from that program because those staff members are more godly and do not live like sinners. I have sinful case managers that are all about their own understanding and think you are crazy as you worship and live for only God. sinful case managers at homeless shelters

that are not godly think about themselves to boost their own and be all about their own understanding. That is 100% fact.

I want to tell you to do what is right for you in your life. If you are trying to better yourself economically and financially, do what is right for you by listening and letting Christ Jesus follow you. It is like I learned from the lectures about vision and pain from Pastor John Johnso at Star of Hope Mission in Houston. Whoever the person is talking to thinks they know everything about you and thinking what is best for you in your life, do not listen to that sinful and sin information. That is why we do not need to be so enthusiastic about voting in this election because we do not need Kamala Harris and/or Donald Trump to help and guide us to have a vision in our daily lives. We need to rely on God and his kingdom in heaven to give and guide us through our vision on earth. Democrats and Republicans in congress are not the people to guide us with vision while on earth to do what is right in our life. We suffer and have tribulations while on earth because Christ Jesus wants us to have vision. That is 100% fact. What I am saying is to fear Christ Jesus as our personal savior and let him help us with vision, so we do not have to go through pain from the sinful world. I strongly agree with the senior citizen woman who told her in the movie Meet the Browns, never stop doing the right thing in your life. She explained to her how she will get a breakthrough in her life while she continues to do the right thing and do what is right. I like Star of Hope Mission in Houston and the case managers there because most case managers are senior pastors of churches and seem like they do not do their jobs for the money or are one of those organizations all about greed to keep their grant money flowing in to try to keep clients in the facility longer. When I was admitted to the Spiritual Recovery Program at Star of Hope Mission in Houston, case managers cared about clients to teach them how to live with prosperity in their life as having strong faith in God. That is the advice that I will continue to use while I am back living in Detroit after August 28, 2024 in my own permanent housing and living with more economic stability. When I read and pray on Galatians 6:9-10, I never give up. What I have to do is listen to God in my life as man of God and bishop to this congregation. I have nine days to be living here in New York State and I am gone back to Detroit on the morning of August 28, 2024.

This is the list God is guaranteed to call to do and what I will do in Detroit.

- 1. I will do more to donate my own personal money to help the homeless on the streets in Detroit. I just have to have money on me to give because I use a lot of debit and credit in retail stores.
- 2. I will go back to volunteering at homeless shelters in Detroit
- 3. When I do not preach at my own church in Detroit, I will attend other churches in Detroit to continue to strengthen friendships with those pastors.
- 4. I will make sure and help out with my congregation to make sure the church is doing more to keep homeless men and women off the streets in Detroit and stop food insecurity.
- 5. I will go back to living in the household with the First Lady Jennifer in Detroit.
- 6. I use the knowledge from Star of Hope Mission in Houston from Financial Management class to live spiritually and economically by the instructor Mr. Turner.

I want you to go home tonight and think about what you want to do in your life that is right for you. I need you to think about what you want to do in your life that is right for you without the sinful world and sinful people coming in to discourage you from trying to do what you know is right for you and your life.

Do not listen to any sinful case managers if you are homeless that are not godly and all about their own understanding. Those sinful people are trying to make you fail because they want to relapse and continue to be conformed to the sinful world. Turn to the person next to you and say do not be a failure by relying and listening to people in the sinful world. Turn to the person on the other side of you and say do not let the devil control you.

"I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway. But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it. I have discovered this principle of life—that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. I love God's law with all my heart. But there is another power[a] within me that is at war with my mind. This power makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me. Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death? Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. So you see how it is: In my mind I really want to obey God's law, but because of my sinful nature I am a slave to sin."-Romans 7:19-25
