We know it talks about shepherds negatively in some parts of the Old Testament, but it also talks about serving God as a good shepherd in the Old and New Testament. We want to be obedient to the word in the bible when it talks about being a good shepherd to God and the Holy Spirit to be able to get through the Tabernacle and grow our hearts as a mustard seed to heaven. Turn to the person next to you and say I want to be a good shepherd to God and his kingdom. Good shepherds to God provide nourishment and direction in people like to make them humble and obedient to God and Holy Spirit as rock of our salvation forever to eternal life in heaven. I need you to write this down about nourishment and put it in your bible to remember to look at it daily. I provide nourishment and direction to individuals in the pulpit, outside of the pulpit when I am surrounded by the right people and people in my inner circle. God hates people on earth that look down on people. I do not look down on people as a shepherd and man of God. I may ignore wicked people that want me to sin and have them intimidate me, but I do not do that because Christ Jesus protects me with his wall of angels around me from heaven. I continue to say over and over again that my family members on my mother side and stepfather side of the family when they look down on me at the time when I tried to get my higher education at DePaul University, but let sit out in the cold to worry about pursuing my own higher education at DePaul University. Mother and stepfather along with their sides of the family did not want to help me get my higher education at DePaul University with an outside student loan to pay for the remainder of my tuition and lost my student housing in Lincoln Park

campus. That is how I became homeless for the first time. I still have not forgiven them for that moment in time. They let me struggle with homelessness by living at a homeless shelter to pursue my higher education. What they did was they did everything backwards with me because I actually pursued my higher education with college degrees and certifications. My sister did not do that. My mother and stepfather made a bad investment at the time because my sister got accepted at a university in Northwest Indiana after South Suburban College, she obtained bad academic progress and lost her financial aid, and it was student loans taken out for her that my stepfather is still paying for today. These are 100% facts, my sister lost her financial aid in Northwest Indiana because of her academic progress and was placed on academic probation for one semester to get over a 2.0 GPA and failed at it. Right now, I am more successful and sophisticated than my sister based on my portfolio and resume. I just need to do better for myself like it is mentioned in my biography on the church website. You see homeless men and women looking down on other homeless people with lack of respect for them. It is either they are goal-oriented and all about themselves. I do not look down on the poor and homeless people while being mistreated by police, politicians and public officials, hurting financially and living on the streets, racial profiling by police and public. Looking down on others is an abomination from God. An abomination from God is supporting and aiding the wicked for his wicked ways daily.

- 1. If we stay committed to God and the Holy Spirit, what can be gotten from God in our life to lead us to righteousness and depend on the world?
- 2. If we stay committed to God and the Holy Spirit as a homeless person, what can we get from God that can guide us through our worship of God while dealing with trials and tribulations?
- 3. What do we need to continue to do to grow our hearts as a mustard seed to heaven and God daily?
- 4. What do we need to do to remain loyal to God to help Christ Jesus build us up in Christ and allow our hearts to grow as a mustard seed?
- 5. What do I need to do to follow the path of righteousness to Christ Jesus and his kingdom? For example, what do I need to sacrifice in my life to grow as a mustard seed to heaven?
- 6. How do I need to strengthen my heart as mustard seed to let God bless me as a cheerful giver and not be all about myself as a taker on earth?

Your Spiritual Journey as a Shepherd

- 1. When I talk about improving your inner circle to God and the Holy Spirit, our inner circle are our disciples to God and our flock. We must look out for our people in our inner circle and flock. We must lead and be a leader in our flock. I am a leader among my 43 disciples daily by looking out for them daily and checking on them daily as a shepherd and man of God.
- 2. We must care for one another and our flock known as our disciples daily.
- 3. We must serve as representatives of God, people and kingdom while on earth by preaching the word of God, living an obedient life to God and Holy Spirit. Turn to Isaiah 63:11 in your bibles and read Isaiah 63:11 and Jeremiah Jeremiah 23:2.
- 4. We must not be afraid to live a life under boundaries and obeying rules. This is the key thing homeless men and women do not like doing and do not want to help themselves at homeless shelters to transform themselves to seek God in their life. It is like I said before that I have witnessed clients leave the Star of Hope Mission in Houston because they do not want to help themselves and seek God in their life. Homeless shelters need to help force clients to seek God in

- their life to stop them from being conformed to the world and stop them from relapsing into the world to go down the same path of sin, wickedness and unrighteousness. Turn to the person next to you and say homeless people need to transform to God.
- 5. We need to watch out for our enemies that want to negatively attack us while on earth. Do not retaliate against them. We need to let Christ Jesus handle it at the throne in heaven because he is the judge that can judge our hearts.
- 6. We need to stay committed and continue to follow Christ Jesus in our life daily by staying on the path of righteousness. It means we need to live a new life in Christ without sin, temptation, abomination, trials and evil. We need to meet new people and communicate with our disciples in our inner circle that is willing to provide knowledge about God and talk about the goodness of God in our discussions.
- 7. As servants and shepherds to God, we must be trustworthy while serving God including pastors that have been living rich lifestyles living off their congregation tithes and offerings to buy mansions, business jets and fancy cars; but do not offer help to other churches and houses of worship. I heard negative things about Pastor Corey Brooks from Chicago being this way. I do not like to negatively attack and discriminate against Pastor Corey Brooks because I have high respect for him and his church project called "Project Hood." I have respect for Creflo Dollar as well but I do not like his conjugation because he does not provide financial support to other churches, but rather builds the church wealth and builds his own personal wealth.
- 8. We must be sacrificial and be willing to make sacrifices to God, keep our love and remain loyal to him, so we can get into the kingdom after we die on earth.
- 9. We must be loyal and 100% invested in God and his kingdom by being obedient and serving him on earth daily in life and hearts forever. It means start accepting God in our life with his blessings and mercies along with being a cheerful giver to the Lord. The truth is God does not worship takers on earth and those people do not witness good things in their life. Whatever good things people conformed from the world get in their life is from the world without God being their source. Turn to the person next to you and say let God be your source.
- 10. Read the bible and let Christ Jesus give you a vision for your life that will lead you to the path of righteousness and let our hearts grow as a mustard seed to heaven.
- 11. Be a rational christian and good shepherd to God and the Holy Spirit.
- 12. We need to stop eating pork as shepherds to God because it is an abomination from God.
- 13. Tattoos on the body is a sin and ungodly that is why people like me do not have tattoos.
- 14. No greed as a shepherd to God.
