Ten percent of revenue used to help the homeless from Homelessness Financial Relief Program and Emergency Assistance Program in 2018 based on financial records and receipts. Eighty-nine percent revenue used to pay for church operations based on financial records and receipts. Thirteen percent revenue used to help the homeless from Homelessness Financial Relief Program and Emergency Assistance Program in 2019 based on financial records and receipts. Eighty-six percent revenue used to pay for church operations based on financial records and receipts.
