I want to start off by telling you a true life story about myself. I do not treat God and his kingdom as a revolving door because I start and continue to let God work through me to offer me the breakthrough he wants for me in my life. I learned that from clients and staff at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston while I was in the Spiritual Recovery Program. I learned from spiritual clients at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston to let God work through me even though times of crisis and tribulations in my life. This prevents me from making decisions too fast and quickly. Staff at Star of Hope Mission says that I need to stop making decisions too fast and quickly until God blesses me with a breakthrough. I know that it was God's kingdom and from heaven that I got a recent breakthrough that will turn the page in my life that I can 100% move on as Senior Pastor and Bishop of this congregation. I told you previously in my previous testimonies during services that I feel a breakthrough coming from heaven and Christ Jesus in the next few weeks. That breakthrough happened yesterday and involved me establishing myself in Brooklyn long-term and not moving around from city-to-city and state-to-state. I want to say thank you to Christ Jesus for my recent breakthrough. Thank you Christ Jesus for your breakthrough that I can finally move on and economically establish myself in Brooklyn long-term.

When I read Ephesians 4:29, I think about what I tell people about my childhood not being raised in a christian household. I mentioned this in my mandatory testimony on commencement at Star of Hope Mission in Houston while I was commencing from Spiritual Recovery Program to TLC. My step-father used to speak foul and abusive language with profanity on a daily basis. He still does that today and explains why my mother and step-father have really started to have marriage problems after so many years. When parents speak with abusive and foul language in the household, the children will more likely grow up that way. That's why boys and girls today talk to people in public with foul and abusive language

with profanity with their parents or family members around. I need to ask what happened to the days when people like myself were children and we knew not to do that kind of stuff. What happened to the days when children used to respect their elders and stop being judgemental of everybody? Fathers are supposed to be the most disciplined parent in the household, but many of these households do not have fathers and mothers are raising these children by themselves. People like me learned not to be judgemental to people in public or private settings. People like me in the millennial generation taught right from wrong. People like me during my childhood were raised and knew how to act respectful like children with foul and abusive language. When I read Ephesians 4:29, we need to be encouraging others as mentors and leading them down the path of righteousness to be able to be christ children to God kingdom to be able to get to heaven. Children need to be cautious with their freewill to make more Godly decisions. We need to be saying good and encouraging things about people, not be all about hate, envy, and jealousy.

I say as christian and disciples to Christ Jesus that we need to eliminate bitterness, rage, anger and evil behavior as part of our personalities like it says in Ephesians 4:31. Ephesians 4:31 takes me back to Proverbs 10:6-14 when it talks about wickedness and people with wicked ways. That's why Ephesians 4:29-32 and Psalm 10:6-14 are my favorite scriptures in the bible. It teaches us how we need to be righteous christians and disciples to eliminate wicked and wicked ways in our lives on earth. This needs to be taught to the homeless at homeless shelters and live on the streets rather than live with mental health with evil behavior, rage, bitterness and anger. Turn to the person next to you and say I want to live a righteous Christian life without rage, bitterness, anger and evil forever. Turn to the person on the other side of you and say be kind and forgiving to one another. If you ever been homeless at a homeless shelter and/or lived on the streets, the scripture Ephesians 4:26 speaks to us and myself that homeless men and women with anger and rage let evil and sin control them. That needs to stop and more homeless shelters need to be more Christ-centered organizations. I disagree with people that homeless shelters do not want to force religion and serve God as our personal savior. That needs to happen at homeless shelters today.

What do we need to do to prevent our lives from being a revolving door?

1. Do not tell lies and live your life providing false reports about others.
2. Stop being judgemental about others and worry about yourself daily.
3. Stop being judgemental about others and thinking you know everything by worrying about your own life.
4. Be truthful 100% daily.
5. Live a humble and truthful life by not listening to people in the world all about sin and idolatry.
6. Let our hearts grow as a mustard seed to heaven and Christ Jesus.

In Romans 8:26, it says the Holy Spirit helps us with our weaknesses and needs to let God help us with our weaknesses and tribulations. We need to stop relying and be conformed to the world to help us with our weaknesses because that is what the devil wants us to do in our life to defy God and his kingdom. We must continue to pray to heaven and Christ Jesus because God can help us with any situation we are involved in daily. My 43 disciples live a committed prayer life that they pray to God daily like me. I may not bow down and pray on my knees, but I do talk to God daily when I am by myself and around other people. It means that when I am talking to myself that I am talking to my heavenly father Christ Jesus. That is 100% fact. To put that out there saying that when I do that as a man of God and Bishop, I am not

crazy and I am talking to my personal savior Christ Jesus. When I do that as a man of God, Christ Jesus hears me and explains my breakthroughs that I always get from God's kingdom. It is how I am able to remain distant from evil with God's protection from sinful people and the world while Christ Jesus as a wall of angels around me daily from heaven. Turn to the person next to you and say sin=death. Turn to the person on the other side of you and say I am a child of God. Read Romans 8:13-14.

I need you to turn and Read Galatians 5:16 because it is important scripture that we need to know and sink in our minds daily. You all know Galatians 5:16 is all about and what it says, but I am reading the scripture out of the NLT version of the bible. After I commenced and left Star of Hope Mission in Houston, I let Galatians 5:16 become knowledgeable to me daily. It is the same thing staff and case managers were telling me while I was in the Spiritual Recovery Program was telling me to let God guide me and stop making decisions too fast and quickly that can lead me back to depending on the world. The scriptures us to avoid living in sinful nature and living in sin. Everyone needs to let God guide us. It is what I say about our politicians and people like Kamala Harris and Joe Biden telling us to listen to them to support abortion and reproductive rights. Kamala Harris and Joe Biden are part of the world telling us to ignore God as the creator of human life on earth to encourage women to get abortions. It is the same thing about the Democrats in the US House of Representatives. and the Senate. We need to stop listening to idolatry in the world and start reading the bible to listen to God's wisdom from heaven. God will judge idolatry in this world when the day comes for them to face Christ Jesus at the throne in heaven. Turn to the person next to you and say do not get sucked in the sinful world and idolatry.
