I want to start off telling a true story about myself to let you know what I do. If I am confused about what I want to do in my life, I call on God to guide me. I learned this continuously while I was at Star of Hope Mission in Houston to let God guide me if I am feeling confused about decisions in my life. When I leave the Bronx on August 28, 2024; I will continue to communicate with staff from Star of Hope Mission in Houston on my well-being in Detroit. I will not talk and/or keep in touch with no one in New York State or the Bronx after August 29, 2024. I am grateful for all the advice that I got from staff at the Star of Hope Mission in Houston while I was in the Spiritual Recovery Program. I felt more comfortable in that program and working my way in that program because I was never a loner, always by myself and always myself up to meet new people in the facility and program. I do not get that here in the Bronx and New York State. That is why I rather just move back to Detroit to focus on my congregation, operations and communicating with members. More of the members want me back in the Detroit community. It was at times that I wanted to make decisions too fast in the program at Star of Hope Mission in Houston, but thank God for the spiritual guidance and direction I received in the Spiritual Recovery Program. After I leave the Bronx and New York State, I will just move on and never look back while I am in Detroit. I usually never look back on things in my life. I just focus on looking forward. People told me in recent days in Houston that my future is bright when I move to Detroit. They were clients at Star of Mission in Houston and spiritual like I am.

When I was living in Detroit in the past, I noticed that I had more economic stability than in other places. I got and received more blessings in Detroit than anywhere else. I have not received a lot of blessings here in New York State and Brooklyn. My economic situation in New York State right now has been so-so. People like my biological father and parents always tell me that people have to do what is best for them. Any case manager or professional in places like New York State cannot make the decisions for you in your life while you are confused. Turn to the person next you and say listen and call on God in your life when confused about something. I say again that homeless shelters in the Bronx are bad like NYPD officers have said as well. I got elevated to Bishop in Detroit in front of members of the congregation. I was able to start meeting new people first hand that are spiritual in Detroit in 2017. I was able to meet new people fast when I was first admitted to the spiritual recovery program at Star of Hope Mission in Houston.

What to do if you are confused in your life?

- 1. Trust in the Lord and not sinners and sinful world because it can keep you righteous in your life.
- 2. Do not lean on your own understanding and become a fool like it says in the bible.
- 3. Pray to God and let Christ Jesus show you the way in your life to the path of righteousness.
- 4. Do not be anxious about anything in your life
- 5. Pray to God with thanksgiving
- 6. Study prayers in the bible
- 7. Talk to the pastor or Bishop if you are confused in your life.
- 8. Reading the bible daily
- 9. Talk to a christian friend that is a christian and disciple to Jesus.
