Christ loves people that love their neighbors and do not hate and instigate towards others to act envy and jealousy to other people. All I say is that it is good to stay in school and study hard. I am successful and sophisticated because I stayed in school and studied hard on the southside of Chicago by attending and graduated from Morgan Park High School and I attended three elementary schools. I started out at Ryders Elementary School, Fort Dearborn Elementary School and Esmond Elementary School. I graduated from Esmond Elementary School and passed the US Constitution test as a graduation test. Christ loves people that care for the poor and homelessness by living for God as a cheerful giver. "He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the LORD require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God."-Micah 6:8

This verse talks about true worship involving living a life characterized by justice, mercy and humility before God. It is a call to internal transformation rather than external performance. We need to treat people fairly regardless of their background, status and beliefs. When I read this scripture, I think about what my stepfather told me and my sister not let no one take advantage of us. My friend Bufus from the time I was at Star of Hope Mission in Houston in 2023. I am a pragmatic person that stands up for what is right for communities and this nation.

When I read the scripture, I think about people in shared room living situations with mental health problems and anger issues that are haters, instigators to other people. People with mental health programs are dealing with disrespect, sin and resentment. Those are dealing with jealousy and envy according to the bible. When people study hard and work toward their goal in life with God's vision for your life that there is no reason to hate. I want to tell you a true story about the men at the location in

Detroit located at 2654 Sturtevant Street in Room 4 and 6 about their envy and jealousy towards and have no respect for their elders and people like myself that are ordained religious leaders. I say that shared room living situations are bad situations to be in unless you are surrounded with the right and mature people. People need to worry about their own life and destiny because that is what the bible says that we need to do and stop instigating towards other people and hating on their professional background. Younger guy at 2654 Sturtevant Street #6 is dealing with resentment, sin, abomination from God, wicked and ungodly. I called him one of those false prophets and believe he will be judged at the throne in heaven along with the guy at 2654 Sturtevant Street #4 that is wickedness, sin and resentment as well. That's why the truth is they hate on my life that I have three children by my spouse Jennifer that is in Chicago with them while attending Chicago Public School. They have nothing and will never have nothing. We need to start acting justly to look for opportunities. People need to start showing mercy for people that make mistakes and approach situations with humility. This means advocating for fairness, offering forgiveness, and being open to understanding others perspectives. Also, I believe the young guy in room#6 is noisy and is listening to my conversations while talking to my family and church staff on the phone and I believe he is an instigator, sinner, representing abomination and idolatry in the world. "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; love and faithfulness go before you."-Psalm 89:14

The verse asserts the incomparable power and righteousness of God, even as it laments the temporary downfall of David's kingly line, which was a temporary disruption but did not invalidate God's eternal promises. The psalmist initially praises God for His mighty power. The psalmist also acknowledges the king's sin and God's disciplinary action, leading to the profanation of the royal crown. The psalmist concludes by reaffirming the foundation of God's throne in righteousness and justice and the accompanying promise of mercy and truth. The verse offers a message of hope that in a world where justice is often lacking, the ultimate foundation of rule is divine righteousness and justice. Righteousness and justice are the foundation of God's throne.

The congregation created the Office of Honesty and Transparency to provide more honesty and transparency for church operations. I implemented the new department under executive order and signed it while I was in Chicago previously. Outsiders and envious people that think they know everything about me and church operations. The department makes those judgmental people feel small. Giving in secret promotes humility and prevents pride from creeping into one's actions. It acknowledges that all good comes from God and that we are simply conduits of His blessings.

"Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed. Take up the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow."-Isaiah 1:17

God's desire is not just empty ritual, but genuine actions of righteousness, social justice, and compassion for the most vulnerable in society. You have people in society that do not practice righteous behavior. I am moving from 2654 Sturtevant Street that were moved up to Saturday because friends and family told me in recent days that I need to remove myself from evil and wickedness people and environment known as the males at the location in Room 4 and 6 are wicked, haters, instigators, sinful, idolatry and abomination from God towards people like me and I believe they have mental health problems, depression, lack respect for others, anger problems and dealing with resentment.

"Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices—mint, dill and cumin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law—justice, mercy and faithfulness. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former."-Matthew 23:23

"The LORD loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of his unfailing love."-Psalm 33:5

The verse encourages worship by reflecting on God's love, justice, and steadfast love that are evident in the world and fulfilled in Jesus Christ. The Hebrew word for "unfailing love" (*chesed*) denotes God's covenant loyalty, mercy, and steadfast love. This loving devotion permeates creation and is a source of praise. God's word is "right and true" and He is "faithful in all he does. This establishes God's reliability and the foundation of His relationship with humanity. This power and wisdom are further evidence of His character and reasons to stand in awe of Him.

I want to tell a true story about R.Kelly and his situation. I grew up on R.Kelly and his music as a child. I do not want to say that he got what he deserved by being sentenced to prison. I believe women treated him unfairly with their sexual assault accusations on him. We live in a society where women act so fast towards men that are famous and use them to make themselves famous in whatever they can. I believe that what happen with R.Kelly that women used him to seduce him and then accused him for sexual assault. I really hate to see R.Kelly in prison and the women taking his life away from him. If the women were spiritual, all they had to do is repent and confess their sins and move on with their life. Also, I believe homeless people are treated unfairly on the streets because the bible says that we are supposed to be cheerful givers and help the poor and do not be public about it. When the church created the Homelessness Financial Relief Program in 2014 while the congregation started on the westside of Chicago, the church created the program to help the homeless and poor with their financial instability and lack of permanent housing. The church provided assistance from the program in Cleveland to 18 homeless men with their financial instability and poverty in 2017 according to reports from the Benevolence Ministry. The church provided financial assistance from the program in Detroit to 31 homeless men and women in the Detroit area in March 2017 to September 2018 according to reports from the Benevolence Ministry. The church provided financial assistance to two homeless men with their poverty and financial instability in Louisville in February 2020 and October 2021 according to reports from the Benevolence Ministry. When I first moved to Detroit in 2017 and lived in Highland Park in March 2017, I always received undeserved compassion from other men in the shared room living situation. That's why I say that I am more focus and caution to be surrounded with people or environment with more people that are mature and depend on heavenly wisdom daily, not be around people that disobey God commandments by bearing false witness against others and think they know it all about people that gossip about people thinking they know it all. In 2017, an older guy told me that the room feels anointed when he enters the room and I am reading the bible. When I was in Baltimore in 2024, I witnessed a person that was so sinful and ungodly that I found out from people that the guy had the devil in him and told people he saw demons and evil spirits. I am taking the advice from my case manager Mr Gray while I was in the Spiritual Recovery Program at Star of Hope Mission in Houston in 2023. When I was in Chicago,, I attended Salem Baptist Church of Chicago Celebrate Recovery meetings every week to work on my hurts, habits and hangups in 2014 to 2015. I continued to attend the meetings because members and staff managed the Celebrate Recovery meetings and said in their own words how compassionate I was helping people dealing with any hurts, habits and hangups. That's why my other spiritual gift is exhortation. Exhortation means to strongly encourage, advise, or urge someone to take a specific course of action, often related to faith, repentance, or spiritual growth.

"But the LORD Almighty will be exalted by his justice, and the holy God will be proved holy by his righteous acts."-Isaiah 5:16

This verse serves as a counterpoint to the preceding lament over Israel's corruption and unrighteousness. This verse serves as a counterpoint to the preceding lament over Israel's corruption and unrighteousness. God's character of justice and holiness will ultimately be displayed and recognized through His judgment. This verse can serve as a source of comfort, reassuring people that God is ultimately in control and will bring about true justice. God is sanctified or compelled to be recognized as holy through His execution of justice.

When I read this scripture, I think about the time in Chicago with the congregation that I always stuck to one rule “it is my way or the highway.” Friends and a former Vice President candidate when I ran for President of Student Government at City Colleges of Chicago-Malcolm X College told me that I need to stop promoting that rule as Senior Pastor of the church because it will lead to consequences and no one will not want to work for me. I used to say that slogan proudly to church staff and volunteers in Chicago when the church did business and started out in the Douglass Park area on the west side of Chicago. Friends told me that they saw the rule in 2014 to 2015 as a respect towards others and taking away their free speech. After eliminating and stopping promoting that rule to staff in Chicago, I started being open to other staff and volunteers ideas because people I was just thinking about myself while saying “it is my way or the highway” in 2014 to 2015. When I may take a stand on an issue and post on social media and during services, I always get pushback on this issue. For example, opposition to same-sex marriage, abortion and reproductive rights, legalizing marijuana, death penalty and LGBTQ community. I have politics in my background and use to standing up strongly for opposition on an issue by life on earth is precious and smoking need to be eliminated as a whole in this nation, respecting God creation of all human life on earth and close abortion clinics to reopen adoption centers in urban and minority communities, the LGBTQ community represent abomination from God and call those people basket of sinful deplorables.

“For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit, because anyone who serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and receives human approval.”-Romans 14:17

The Kingdom of God is not defined by outward practices like what one eats or drinks, but by the internal realities of righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit.
