I want to share a prayer and a true story about my uncle on my mother's side of the family because he just had a minor stroke and is in the hospital in Chicago. I was told that the doctors decided to keep him overnight. I found out that he is at Roseland Community Hospital in Chicago. He is old but I think he is around 70 years old because I never keep up with his age over the years. I ask for you all and this congregation keeps him in your prayers and pray for his health and recovery. My mother told me his speech is more slurred and cannot really understand him. My mother says that children want to be around to bury their mother and father, not all the way around. On my mother's side of the family, it seems like it is all the way round and children are dying before my grandmother. My grandmother is already 93 years old and will be 94 in December.

Romans 11:33-36 Proverbs 9:10 Daniel 2:21-22 Psalm 16:8

As christians and disciples, we must keep our focus on God and the Holy Spirit to know God's presence in our life. We must know God's presence by praying to God with a strong prayer life to the kingdom. We must know God's presence by understanding God is over the heavens and earth that created all human life on earth. When we read Psalm 16:8, we must understand how it is important to us to put God first and know his presence in our life while on earth. We must be stronger disciples and stewards to grow our hearts with faith in God as a mustard seed. Say grow your hearts as a mustard seed to grow your faith in God. We must know God's presence by putting him first and allow Christ Jesus to grow as a mustard seed in our hearts and minds. We must put God first and knowledge of God in our life to put Christ Jesus first

by serving the kingdom and being a good steward. We need to let God move us in our life and stop the devil from moving us in the wrong direction, such as the path of righteousness. We need to pray for our families because families are becoming more divided and distant from each other. That is not a Godly thing. We need more Godly families that will put God first and let God move you in your life. When you read further in Psalm 16:9-11, we need to know God and praise God with gladness. Say to the person next to you: let your life be glad and rejoice for God. Say to the person on the other side of you: live for God with glory.

I encourage you to read Psalm 16:8-11 daily to know God and let God move you to let your faith in God grow as a mustard seed.

When we read Proverbs 9:10, we must fear the Lord like we fear our parents because we are gaining wisdom to know how to live right and wrong. We have the reason to fear the Lord because we are getting to know God and what is allowed for his kingdom. We have the reason to fear the Lord because God is the one that can judge us on earth and at the throne in his kingdom after we die on earth. We have the reason to fear the Lord because we can perish and Christ Jesus can cut us off if we continue to live in the path of unrighteousness while on earth. We have reason to fear the Lord because we have to make sacrifices in our life to make our faith and hearts whole for the kingdom. We must understand that we cannot be lopsided Christians and disciples. We must live for God as a servant and disciples in order to grow our hearts as a mustard seed for the kingdom.

When you read Romans 11:33-36, we must do the following to grow our hearts as a mustard seed to grow our faith in God and the Holy Spirit to get to the Most Holy Place in the Tabernacle.

- 1. We must be sharing with others and not be selfish to be all about ourselves.
- 2. Live in the Glory to the kingdom forever
- 3. Live in the glory of God forever.
- 4. Pray and meditate to Christ Jesus daily for your needs and wants
- 5. Pray and praise God to move you in your life to continue to get breakthrough from the kingdom.
- 6. Live in the glory for God to be obedient and anointed to him.
